AGENDA ITEM TITLE:	Tennis Court and Pickleball Resurfacing
DEPARTMENT SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:	Parks and Recreation is seeking approval to resurface five tennis courts and repurpose courts 6-7 to permanent Pickleball Courts.
	This project went to RFP on July 24, 2023, and remained until August 30, 2023, but we didn't receive any bids. We solicited quotes from Signature Tennis, Talbot Tennis, and Court Makers, and Signature Tennis was the only Contractor who could start this year.
	They will resurface the courts, tape and fill cracks, sand and repaint net poles, and paint new lines on the tennis courts. Install twelve net posts and six center anchors, a 4-foot fence for separation, six new pickleball nets with straps, and paint lines for the pickleball courts for \$98,400.00.
	This is a budgeted expense, \$80,000 paid from Operating Expenses 100-5100-52-2341 and the remaining \$18,400 from Capital Expenses 100-5100-54-1301. Staff recommends approval.
