AGENDA ITEM TITLE:	Mission Road Sidewalk/Multiuse Trail
DEPARTMENT SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:	Leadership within the City of Cartersville has expressed an interest in providing pedestrian connectivity along West Cherokee Avenue/Mission Road from where the existing sidewalk along West Cherokee Avenue ends at Charles Street to the existing sidewalk approximately 660 feet west of Duncan Drive. A cost estimate to install a 5-foot sidewalk in two phases has been obtained. Phase 1 expands from Charles Street to Stately Oaks Drive, estimated cost at \$3,392,400 and Phase 2 expands from the railroad crossing just west of Silo Drive to approximately 660 feet west of Duncan Drive, estimated at \$2,890,102. Each phase requires a bridge replacement and a pedestrian crossing at the railroad tracks. The cost for a multi-use trail would be approximately twice that of a 5-foot sidewalk since a multi-use trail is 10 feet wide and requires additional right of way.
