AGENDA ITEM TITLE:	Water & Sewer Capacity Fee Update
DEPARTMENT SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:	On May 25, 2000, the City adopted a water and sewer capacity fee ordinance in addition to its normal rates for water and sewer service. The water and sewer capacity fees are deposited into a dedicated City account to fund the expansion and extension of the City's water, wastewater, and sewer facilities and/or capacity. Since the initial ordinance adoption, these capacity fees have not been amended. The City contracted with Hazen & Sawyer to study and update these fees. The resulting recommendations are reflected in this ordinance update.
	The fee changes reflect the actual cost of capacity expansion and extension of City water and sewer facilities and treatment. These one-time fee increases, based on a single-family home inside the City, with ³ / ₄ " meter service will increase by \$160.00 for water and \$170.00 for sewer. Fees for services with larger than 4" meters will be based on an equivalent residential unit (ERU) cost per gallon of capacity requested.
