

A RESOLUTION OF THE CARTERSVILLE SCHOOL BOARD DECLARING THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2025 TO DETERMINE THE REIMPOSITION OR NON-REIMPOSITION OF A ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES; AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Cartersville School Board (the “Board”), which is charged with the duty of managing the affairs of the School System of the City of Cartersville, Georgia (the “City of Cartersville”), the Board of Education of Bartow County, which is charged with the duties of contracting debts and managing the affairs of the Bartow County School District (the “Bartow District”), and the Bartow County Board of Elections and Registration (the “Superintendent of Elections”), which is the Superintendent of Elections of Bartow County, called an election for November 4, 2025, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of Bartow County the question of whether or not a one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes should be reimposed; and

WHEREAS, the ballots used in the election provided that (1) if reimposition of the tax is approved by the voters of the Bartow District, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of the Bartow District in the principal amount of \$75,000,000, and (2) if reimposition of the tax is approved by the voters of the City of Cartersville, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of the City of Cartersville in the principal amount of \$22,870,000 (the “Cartersville Debt”); and

WHEREAS, the returns of the election were duly brought up by the Managers of such election, as required by law, and were presented to the Board, the Board of Education of Bartow County, and the Superintendent of Elections for consolidation and for the declaration of the result of the election; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the election for all of Bartow County were received from all of the poll officers and thereupon the Superintendent of Elections canvassed, computed, and consolidated the returns of the election for all of Bartow County and concurrent with the adoption of this resolution delivered a certified copy of the consolidated return of the election for all of Bartow County to the Board, and the result of the election for all of Bartow County was as follows:

WHEREAS, the returns of the election for the City of Cartersville were received from all of the poll officers and thereupon the Superintendent of Elections canvassed, computed, and consolidated the returns of the election for the City of Cartersville and concurrent with the adoption of this resolution delivered a certified copy of the consolidated return of the election for the City of Cartersville to the Board, and the result of the election for the City of Cartersville was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cartersville School Board, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, that the election resulted in favor of the reimposition of a one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes, by an affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of all of Bartow County voting in the election held for such purpose and by an affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the City of Cartersville voting in the election held for such purpose, that the reimposition of the one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes and the issuance of the Cartersville Debt have been authorized as required by law, and that the results of the election are hereby declared to be as set forth above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the authority aforesaid, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, that a duly certified copy of the consolidated election return of the Superintendent of Elections be attached to this resolution as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.



Shall a one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes of the Bartow County School District (the "Bartow District") and the School System (the "Cartersville System") of the City of Cartersville, Georgia (the "City of Cartersville") be reimposed within Bartow County, upon the termination of the one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes presently in effect, for a maximum period of time of 20 calendar quarters, for the purposes of providing funds to pay (1) for the Bartow District, the cost of acquiring, constructing, and equipping one new middle school to replace an existing middle school; acquiring instructional and administrative technology and communications improvements (including, without limitation, student and staff laptop or other personal devices and necessary software); acquiring school buses, other vehicles, and related transportation equipment; acquiring safety and security equipment; acquiring land for future schools and facilities; adding to, renovating, repairing, improving, and equipping existing school buildings, athletic and fine arts facilities, transportation, maintenance, and other administrative facilities, and other buildings and facilities useful or desirable in connection therewith; and acquiring any necessary property therefor, both real and personal, and, to the extent funds are available, acquiring, constructing, and equipping one new elementary school to replace an existing elementary school and acquiring any necessary property therefor, both real and personal, all at a maximum cost of \$224,453,400; and (2) for the Cartersville System, (a) the cost of adding to, renovating, repairing, improving, and equipping existing school buildings, athletic and fine arts facilities, transportation, maintenance, and other administrative facilities, and other buildings and facilities useful or desirable in connection with Cartersville Primary School, Cartersville Elementary School, Cartersville Middle School, and Cartersville High School; acquiring instructional and administrative technology and communications improvements (including software); acquiring school buses, other vehicles, and related transportation equipment; acquiring safety and security equipment; acquiring land for future schools and facilities, and acquiring any necessary property therefor, both real and personal, all at a maximum cost of \$53,821,100, and (b) the cost of retiring a portion of the City of Cartersville's General Obligation Bonds, Series 2021, or bonds issued by the City of Cartersville to refund such bonds, by paying or making provision for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds coming due on April 1, 2027 through October 1, 2031, in the maximum amount of \$21,725,500?

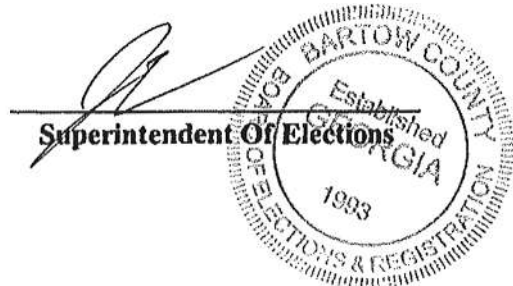
