AGENDA ITEM TITLE:	Tennessee Street Corridor Study
DEPARTMENT SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:	Recently, the Cartersville-Bartow County MPO approved the FY2022 CBMPO Unified Planning Work Program which included a few potential studies within the corporate limits of Cartersville. One study is of the Tennessee Street Corridor which included the portion extending from West Avenue in the south to Felton Road in the north.
	This study, performed by a transportation/planning consultant, would concentrate on traffic flows, pedestrian and bicycle access, visual aesthetics and storm drainage issues.
	The CBMPO anticipates utilizing Federal Metropolitan Planning (PL) Funds for 80% of the cost of this study. The other 20% is considered to be a match from the local municipality that is requesting the study. This study is estimated to be approximately \$200,000. Therefore, the City of Cartersville's contribution would be approximately \$40,000.
	In order to move forward with the application of the PL funds, a resolution of support is needed by the City of Cartersville. We recommend Council approve the attached resolution and authorize the Mayor to sign the resolution on behalf of the City.
