REVISION TO CHARTER AND ADOPTION OF NEW WARD BOUNDARY MAP
FOR ELECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF CARTERSVILLE

Whereas, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Cartersville, at its regularly scheduled meeting on March 17, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., City Council Chambers, 3rd Floor, City Hall, 10 North Public Square, Cartersville, Georgia 30120, will hold a public hearing and a First Reading, and on April 7, 2022, a public hearing and Second Reading on an amendment to the Charter, as detailed herein.

This Amendment is as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT NO. 01-22

- (1) To amend City of Cartersville Charter, Article VII. Elections. Section 7.02. – Wards; Ward residency requirements; elections at large from the 1980 United States Decennial Census to the 2020 United States Decennial Census.
- (2) And to adopt a new Section 7.08. Ward boundaries. Based upon the new Ward Boundary Map of the City of Cartersville.
