

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DACULA, GEORGIA
FOR LEGISLATIVE ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Georgia convenes in January of each year for a legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dacula, Georgia desires to amend its Charter for the purposes of designing certain parcels of land for incorporation into and inclusion within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Dacula, Georgia believe that the designation of certain parcels of land for incorporation into and inclusion within the boundaries of the City is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Dacula; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Dacula propose the following described lands be annexed to the existing corporate limits of the City of Dacula, Georgia, to wit:

All those tracts or parcels of land as indicated herein and shown on a map titled “Proposed Annexations,” said map and listing of tax parcels being attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part of this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dacula that each of the State Representatives and State Senators elected for Gwinnett County should support legislation during the 2026 Session of the General Assembly providing for the annexation of the areas described herein by amending the Charter of the City of Dacula by local act of the Georgia General Assembly in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Georgia.
