**SUBJECT:** Bid package for Dacula Crossing subdivision improvements

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The Dacula Crossing Subdivision Asphalt Milling and Repaving Project bid documents have been finalized and provided for your review. The project scope includes:

- Asphalt deep patch mill sections of road experiencing asphalt failures. Deep patch milled areas will be filled with 4” of 25 mm Superpave Asphalt.
- Milling and repaving the entire road length to be flush with the existing gutter line to include 1” of ‘D’ mix asphalt binder course pavement and 1.5” of Type 1 – ‘F’ Mix (9.5mm) surface course pavement.
- Thermoplastic stop bar striping.
- Sod disturbed areas with Bermuda or in kind.

The proposed improvements have an estimated OPCC (Opinion of Probable Construction Cost) of \$327,060, dated August 5, 2022. The subject project will be funded utilizing Local Maintenance Improvement Grant (LMIG) and SPLOST funds.

Staff requests the Mayor and City Council approve the bid package as provided and grant authorization to solicit for public bids.
