

## MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

**'9-1-1'**

**THIS AGREEMENT**, made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, by and between the CITY OF DALLAS, GEORGIA a municipality of the State of Georgia, and PAULDING COUNTY, GEORGIA, a political subdivision of the State of Georgia, hereinafter collectively "the Parties."

### WITNESSETH

Whereas, the City of Dallas is desirous of implementing a public safety answering point ("PSAP") in accordance with O.C.G.A § 46-5-120, et seq., relating to a statewide Emergency Telephone Number '9-1-1' system plan, and

Whereas, the Parties hereto are desirous of ensuring that all of their citizens receive emergency service in time of need, regardless of jurisdictional boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED among the Parties hereto as follows:

1. The Parties herein receive emergency phone calls relating to public safety.
2. The Parties herein recognize that there is a possibility that a call to one party's PSAP may be answered by the other party's PSAP.
3. To ensure that citizens receive the fastest possible response time, all parties herein agree to transfer calls for service to the appropriate PSAP as soon as possible.
4. The City of Dallas understands that calls requiring a Fire or EMS response will be transferred to Paulding County 911 for dispatch and pre-arrival medical instructions, if needed.
5. The Parties herein agree that any requests for law enforcement mutual aid will be relayed by the receiving PSAP to the appropriate law enforcement agency for response.
6. No party to this agreement will charge another for rendering service in another jurisdictional area under provisions of this agreement.
7. There will be no reimbursement for loss or damage to equipment while engaged in activity pursuant to this agreement.
8. This agreement will be in effect for an indefinite period, or until such time that this agreement is no longer needed.
9. This agreement will be in effect immediately upon the signature of all parties listed herein.
