A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS GRANT FOR THE DALLAS POLICE DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT OF ELSAG STREET SENTRY EQUIPMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Dallas Police Department, through Chief Duvall and Assistant Chief Steve Kish, applied for and was awarded funding under the Project Safe Neighborhoods Gun Violence Reduction Equipment Grant Program, Subaward No. NPSN-26-004; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding is to be used for the acquisition of ELSAG Street Sentry fixed camera equipment, licenses, mounts, installation, and related support, as reflected in the vendor quote in the amount of \$32,070.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been presented with procurement documentation identifying the proposed purchase as a sole source procurement on the grounds that ELSAG ALPR Systems is the only ALPR technology that connects to the National HIDTA LPR Network and provides access to the associated law-enforcement-only network features identified in the supporting materials; and

WHEREAS, the procurement findings, representations, and certifications supporting the sole source determination have been made by the Dallas Police Department, including Chief Duvall and Assistant Chief Steve Kish, and the City Council relies upon those departmental findings for purposes of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, based upon the documentation submitted by the Dallas Police Department, the City Council finds that the proposed purchase satisfies the stated sole source procurement basis and that competitive bidding or the obtaining of competitive quotes is not required for this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dallas, Georgia, as follows:

1. The Project Safe Neighborhoods grant for the Dallas Police Department is hereby accepted.
2. The purchase of the ELSAG Street Sentry equipment and related items from the identified vendor, in an amount not to exceed \$32,070.00, is hereby approved and authorized.
3. The Mayor, City Manager, Police Chief, and such other appropriate City officials are authorized to execute such documents and take such actions as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution and complete the approved purchase.
4. The City Council expressly finds, based upon the procurement documentation and departmental certifications submitted by the Dallas Police Department, that this purchase qualifies as a sole source procurement and that competitive bids or quotes are not required.

5. All findings relating to the technical, operational, and procurement justifications for the sole source determination are those of the Dallas Police Department, including Chief Duvall and Assistant Chief Steve Kish, as reflected in the materials submitted to the City.
