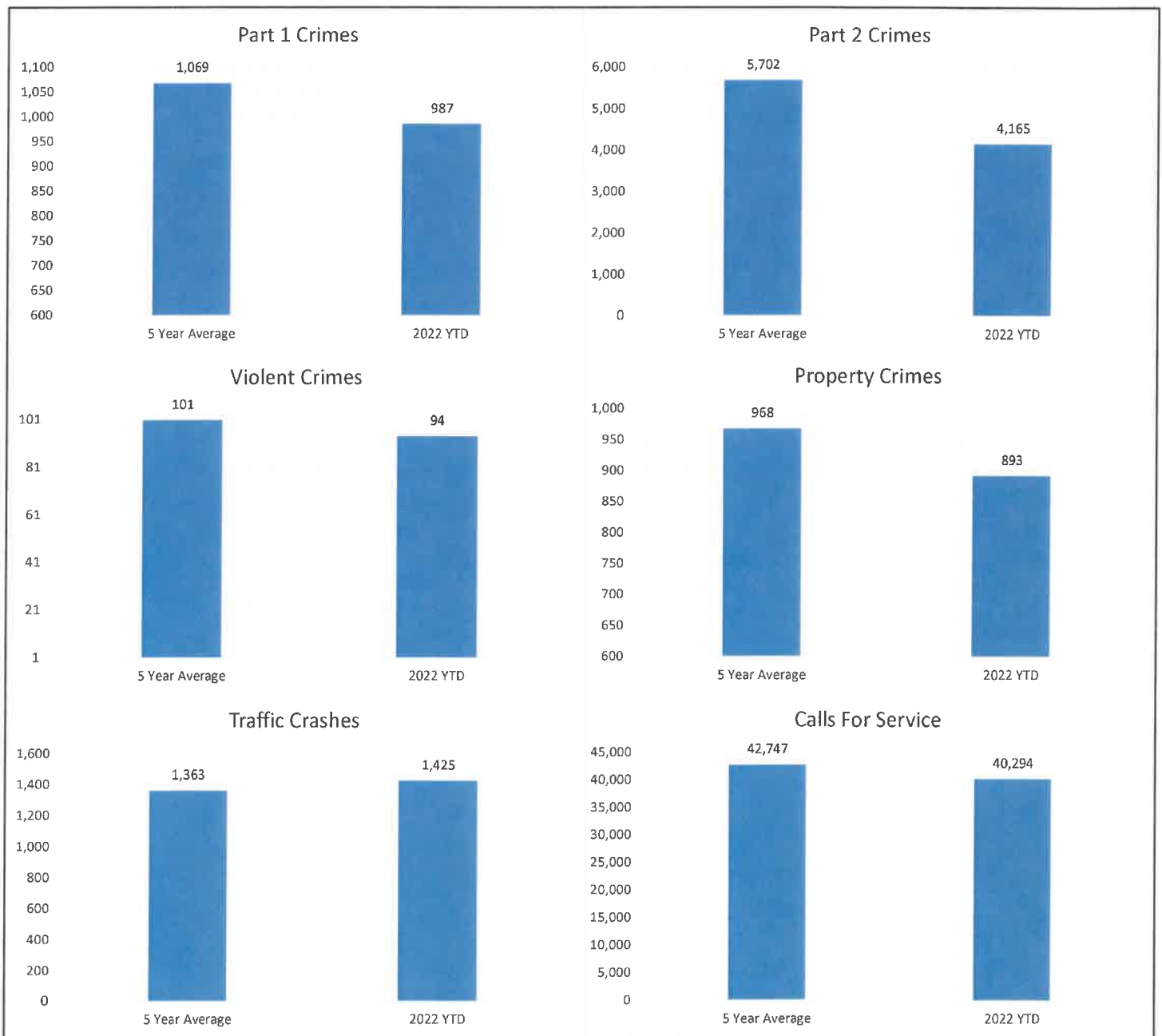

**Summary of Data and Crime Statistics for December 2022**

**General**

The following statistics compare 2022 year-to-date statistics with the previous five years. Part 1 crimes are approximately 7.7% lower than the five-year statistics. Part 2 crimes have decreased by approximately 27% during the same time. Property crimes show a decrease of approximately 7.8% from the five-year average. Violent crimes have decreased by approximately 6.7% from the five-year average of 101. Traffic crashes are approximately 4.6% higher than the five-year average. Calls for service show a decrease of approximately 5.7 during the same time.

**Analysis**

In the year to date 2022 there have been 987 Part 1 crimes reported, compared to 903 in 2021. Traffic crashes have increased approximately 1.8 % from 2021. Calls for service have decreased by approximately 3.9% from 2021.

There have been 94 violent crimes reported 2022 YTD compared to 103 reported violent crimes 2021 YTD. There have been 62 aggravated assaults reported in 2022 compared to 78 in 2021. Year to date property crimes have shown an increase of approximately 11.6% when compared to 2021 YTD statistics.

Based on the statistics from the previous five years, property crime numbers are lower than the average of 968. Violent crime numbers are slightly lower than the five-year average of 100.8.

**December 2022 Crash Statistics**

In December 2022 there were 137 non-private property crashes reported. Non-injury and injury crashes increased over the previous month. Rear end and angle crashes were the most prevalent during December 2022. Following too closely was the leading contributing factor in non-injury crashes. Failure to yield was the leading contributing factor in injury crashes. Walnut Ave had the highest number of non-injury crashes in December 2022. Glenwood Ave had the most injury crashes.
