Please find the attached January 2019 renewal for City of Dalton. We appreciate your partnership in providing your employee health benefits through Alliant Health Plans.

Underwriting determined an increase of 4% is required for the renewal period January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 for the current plan.

Please note:

- ACA compliant plan options are included with your renewal.
- Group dental benefits are available for your employees on either a voluntary, contributory or tied-to-medical basis (information included.)
- The monthly administration fee will not increase.
- Pre-existing exclusions or limitations do not apply.
- To be eligible for coverage as a dependent of a subscriber, an individual must be the lawful spouse of a subscriber, a dependent child of a subscriber, or a young adult child under the age of twenty-six (26). Eligibility for coverage for a dependent child of a subscriber or a young adult child of a subscriber under the age of twenty-six (26) is not based on financial dependency, residency, student status, marital status or employment.
- COBRA Administration is available for \$1 PEPM, if elected.

In order for City of Dalton renewal be processed timely, please note the following requirements:

- The Health Plan Renewal Form and Renewal Plan Election will need to be completed and signed by an Authorized Representative.
- Changes to the contract, such as Waiting Period, Minimum Hours for Eligibility or Amount/Percentage of Employer Contribution should be submitted in writing and will be effective on the renewal date.
- Employees wishing to enroll, add dependents or terminate their coverage should be submitted at this time, as it is their annual open enrollment. Changes made during the open enrollment period will be effective on the renewal date.

Please submit the requirements outlined above to Renewals@AlliantPlans.com no later than December 15, 2018; otherwise, the renewal changes may not be loaded in the system prior to the renewal date which would cause benefit disruption to your employees and their dependents.
