
Violent crimes have increased by approximately 11.76% when compared to 2024. There have been 19 violent crimes YTD 2025 compared to 17 in 2024.

Traffic crashes increased by approximately 24.2% when compared to February 2025. Year to date crashes have decreased by approximately 9.7%. Angle collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Walnut Ave had the highest number of crashes and injuries.
