

# PART 1 CRIMES October 2024

The victim reported he was "jumped" by two unknown males in this area. The victim reported one of the subjects was armed with a knife. The victim was not injured.

A female was severely injured when her ex-boyfriend came to this location, where the victim worked, and stabbed her multiple times with a knife. The suspect was confronted by police in the parking lot. Upon being confronted the suspect stabbed himself. Both parties were taken to the hospital with injuries. The suspect was later arrested and charged accordingly.

There were 62 Part 1 crimes in October 2024. That is decrease of approximately 7.46% compared to 67 in October 2023. Total Part 1 crimes YTD have decreased by approximately 11.14% when compared to 2023.

Violent crimes have increased by approximately 3.64% when compared to 2023. There have been 57 violent crimes YTD compared to 55 in 2023.

Property crimes have decreased by 12.35% when compared to 2023. Larcenies and motor vehicle thefts have decreased, while burglaries have increased YTD compared to 2023 numbers.

#### October 2024

Traffic crashes increased by approximately 10.6% when compared to September 2024. Year to date crashes have increased by approximately 1.3%. Angle and rear end collisions were the most frequent crash types. Failure to yield was the most frequent contributing factor. Walnut Ave had the highest number of crashes. Chattanooga Rd had this highest amount of injuries.
