### SUMMARY OF DATA AND CRIME STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2018

### General

There were 87 Part 1 crimes reported in November 2018 versus 94 in November of 2017. November 2018 had approximately 23.38% less larcenies than the same time in 2017. There were 5 reported aggravated assaults in November 2018. All year to date Part 1 crimes show a decrease except for robbery and motor vehicle thefts. Year to date Part 1 crimes are down 2.09% from 2017.

### Analysis

In the year to date 2018 there have been 1070 Part 1 crimes reported versus 1098 in 2017 which shows an approximate decrease of 2.55%. Robberies have shown an increase when compared to 2017 numbers. Aggravated assaults have decreased by approximately 24.64% in 2018 when compared to 2017.

There have been 92 violent crimes reported 2018 YTD compared to 101 reported violent crimes YTD 2017. That is a decrease of approximately 8.91%. Year to date property crimes have shown a decrease of approximately 1.91% when compared to November 2017 YTD statistics.

Based on the statistics from the previous 5 years, property crime numbers are on the low end of the normal range and show no significant deviation. Violent crime numbers are within the normal range and show no significant deviation.
