| Location: | Burchfield Avenue – James Street Intersection |
| Comments: | The purpose of this Traffic Control Change is to implement a Four-way Stop for the intersection of Burchfield Avenue and James Street. At said location, the City of Dalton Police Department has reported seven accidents in the last four years, with an average of approximately two accidents per year since 2013. The most recent three incidents occurred in the first quarter of 2024. Furthermore, at least two of the historically reported crashes were bicycle related. The 11 th Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, in Section 2B.13 "All-Way Stop control Warrant A: Crash Experience" provides a warrant for all-way stop control where six or more crashes are reported in a 36-month period that were of a type susceptible to correction by the installation of all-way stop control. Moreover, Section 2B.17 "All-Way Stop Control Warrant E: Other Factors" part C. allows for all-way stop control where pedestrian and/or bicyclist movements support the installation of all-way stop control. The intersection in question meets both Warrant A and Warrant E for all-way stop control. If the Traffic Control Change is approved, the Public Works Department will install the required signage. |
