TRAFFIC CONTROL CHANGE

Location:	Both Sides of Loveman Lane
Comments:	The purpose of this Traffic Control Change is to propose "No Parking Both Sides" from the intersection of W. Emery Street extending northward to 509 Loveman Lane, or a distance of 920'. The recommendation comes from Dalton Police Department regarding extremely limited sight distance when vehicles are parked in the roadway. On-site evaluation by Dalton Public Works Traffic Division determines that, because of the steepness of the vertical curve and a posted speed limit of 30 MPH, it is unsafe for vehicles traveling both northbound and southbound to safely navigate around a vehicle parked in the roadway. If the Traffic Control Change is approved, the Public Works Department will install the required signage.
