**Please Provide A Summary of Your Request, Including Background Information to Explain the Request:**

The Public Works Department put out an RFP to replace all of the Public Works maintained decorative post-top lighting at the following locations: Downtown, City Hall, Veterans Park, West Hill Cemetery, 5th Ave/E. Morris St Island, and the Public Works office building. The existing lighting has many deficiencies and outages beyond reasonable repair.

Five proposals were received on August 9th for the subject RFP. The Public Works Department assembled an internal team to evaluate the proposals and score them based on the criteria identified in the RFP. The scores were tabulated and Spring City Electric (Spring City, PA) was selected unanimously as the top proposal with their "New Frontier LED Luminaire".

The cost of the fixtures are \$1,137 each and 290 are needed for a total material cost of \$329,730. These LEDs will be installed by the Public Works Traffic Division. The funding for this project will come from remaining fund balance in the 2007 T-SPLOST safety category. The original project scope had an approved budget of \$275,310, so \$54,420 will be transferred from another project.
