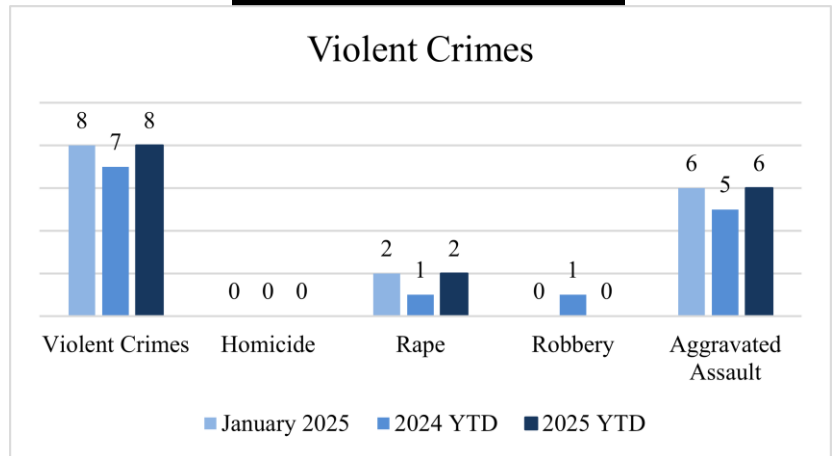

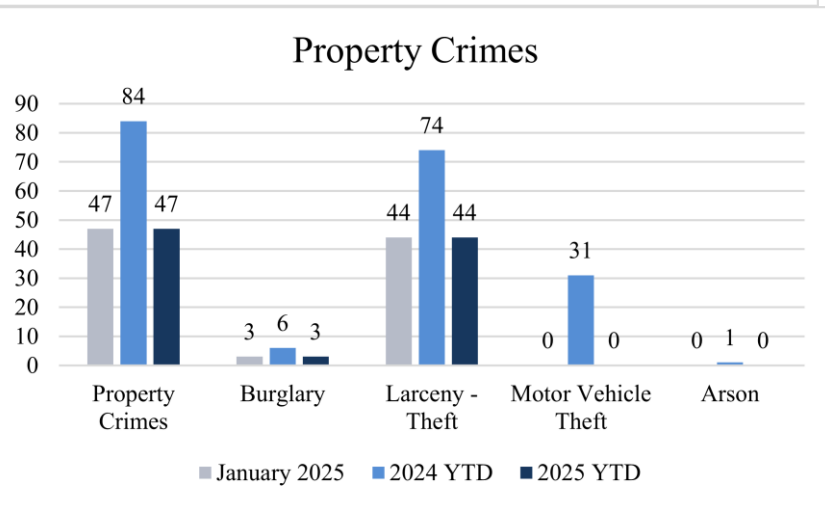

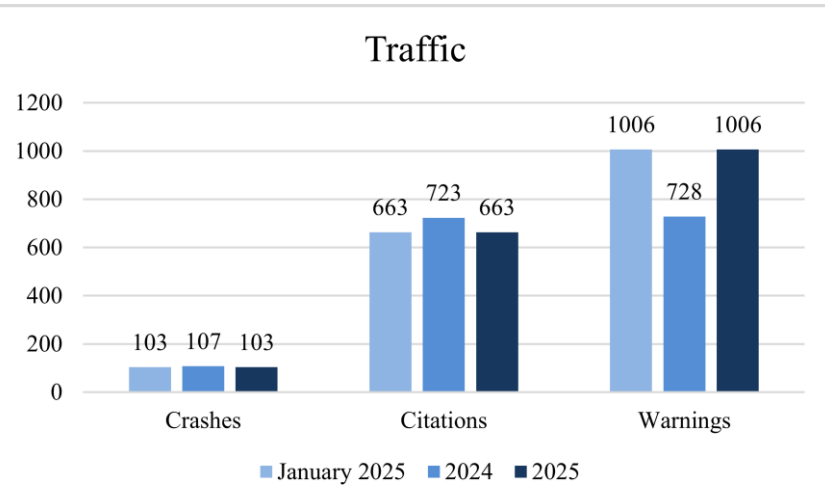

There were 55 Part 1 crimes in January 2025. That is a decrease of approximately 39.56% compared to 91 in January 2024. Total Part 1 crimes YTD have decreased by approximately 39.56% when compared to 2024.

Violent crimes have increased from 8 reported violent crimes from 7 reported violent crimes in 2024. There have been 8 violent crimes YTD 2025 compared to 7 in 2023.

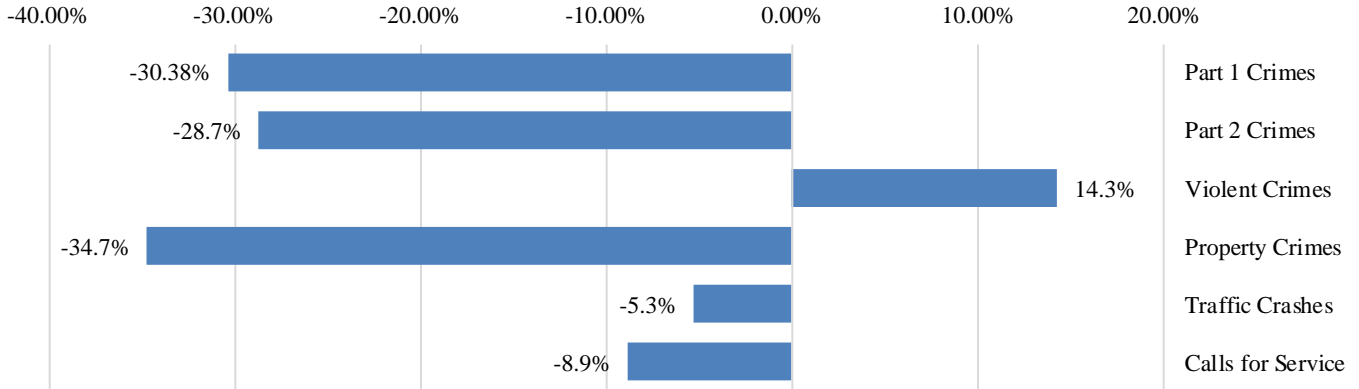
Property crimes have decreased by 44.05% when compared to 2024. All categories of property crimes have shown a decrease YTD compared to 2024.



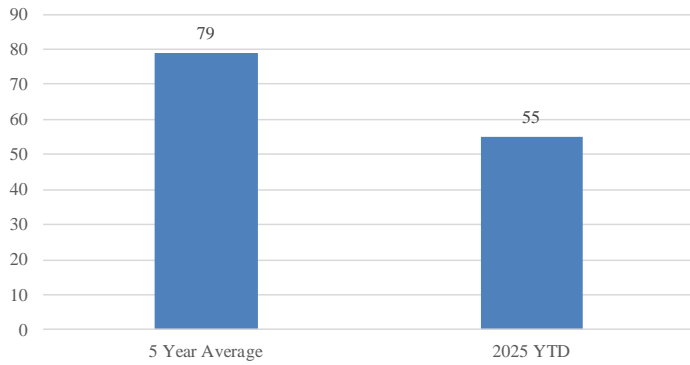
FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE

December 2024

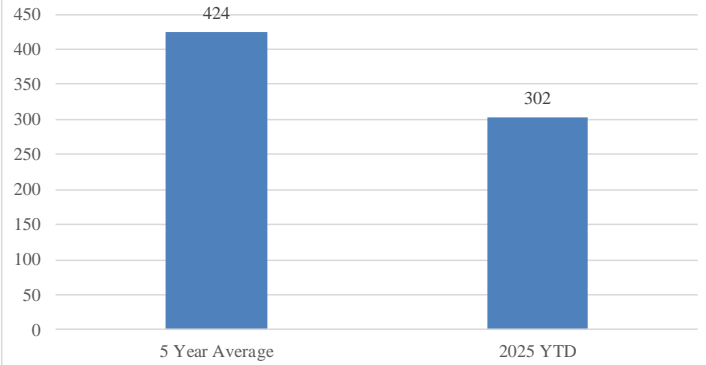
2025 YTD Compared to 5-Year Average



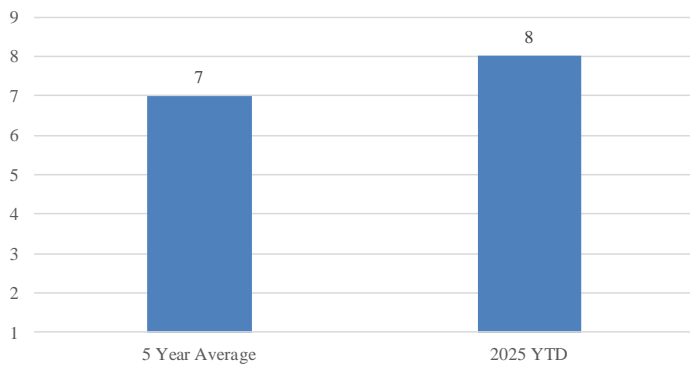

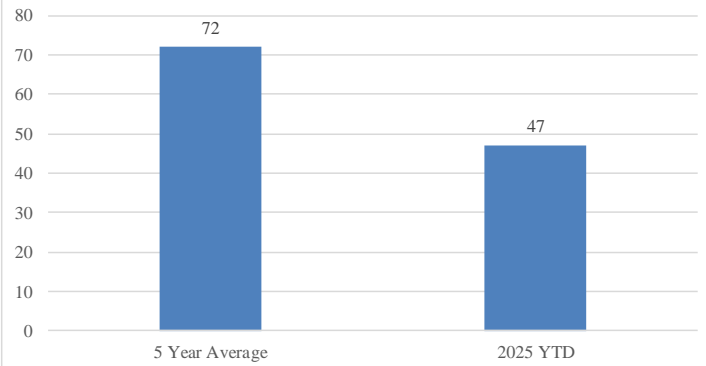

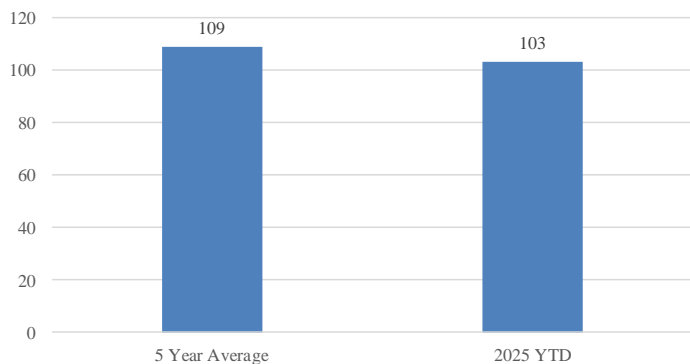

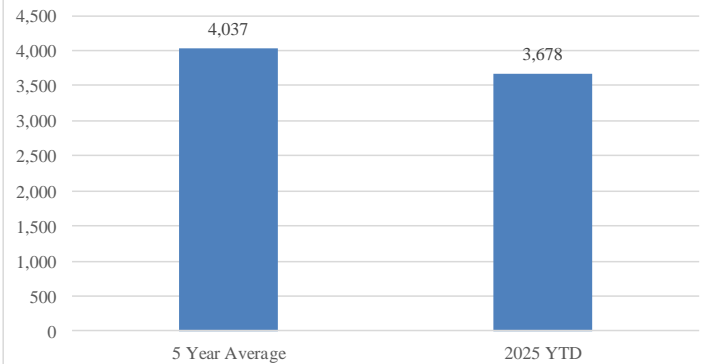

CRASH STATISTICS

January 2025

Traffic crashes decreased by approximately 13.4% when compared to December 2024. Year to date crashes have decreased by approximately 3.7%. Angle and rear end collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Chattanooga Rd had the highest number of crashes. Glenwood Ave had the highest number of injuries.
