
### Summary of Data and Crime Statistics for July 2022

#### General

The following statistics compare 2022 year-to-date statistics with the previous five years. Part 1 crimes are approximately 14.9% lower than the five-year statistics. Part 2 crimes have decreased by approximately 25.4% during the same time. Property crimes show a decrease of approximately 16.0% from the five-year average. Violent crimes have decreased by approximately 4.1% from the five-year average. Traffic crashes are approximately 2.7% higher than the five-year average. Calls for service show a decrease of approximately 9.4% during the same time.

### **Analysis**

In the year to date 2022 there have been 523 Part 1 crimes reported, compared to 517 in 2021. There have been nine more robberies and one homicide reported in 2022, while total violent crime numbers are lower than in 2021.

There have been 56 violent crimes reported 2022 YTD compared to 59 reported violent crimes 2021 YTD. There have been 36 aggravated assaults reported in 2022 compared to 47 in 2021. Year to date property crimes have shown an increase of approximately 2.0% when compared to 2021 YTD statistics.

Based on the statistics from the previous five years, property crime numbers are lower than the average of 556. Violent crime numbers are slightly lower than the five-year average of 58.

### Summary of Significant Events for July 2022

During the month of July 2022 there were five reported arson, which stemmed from the same subject who was going through a mental crisis and believed he needed to set fire to these locations to stop a conspiracy from happening. There was one rape reported during this time and it is currently being investigated. There was one reported robbery, which was cleared by arrest. There were six reported aggravated assault, all six were cleared by arrest. There were five reported burglaries, five of these were cleared by arrest.

Aggravated Assault

1116 Willowdale Rd

A male subject removed a rifle from the trunk of his car and pointed the firearm at several people in the apartment complex. He fired one round towards the building area. Detectives responded to assist with the investigation. The subject was intoxicated and refused to cooperate with the investigation. He was jailed without incident and charged with several felony and misdemeanor crimes.

Officers responded to this location in reference to an employee discovering his vehicle had been entered and a handgun stolen. The caller reported he then heard a male screaming inside one of the open trailers and believed this male may have been the one who stole his firearm. Officers contacted the suspect inside one of the trailers with the stolen gun to his head. He was threatening suicide or suicide by police. He was very erratic. Verbal contact was made and a perimeter was set up. Multiple units arrived along with CID. After around an hour of him refusing to disarm, Detectives were able to get him to lay down the gun long enough for officers to move in and successfully deploy a taser while lethal cover was provided. He was removed from the trailer and taken into custody without further incident. It was determined he entered the victim's car, moved it across the parking lot, and stole the firearm. He was charged with several offenses.

Multiple Cases

Arson

201 S Hamilton St

Officers were dispatched to Wells Fargo downtown in reference to an alarm and a witness seeing a white male break into the building. There was also a report of a fire. The white male fled the scene in a Honda van which was located traveling west on Hawthorne St. The suspect saw the patrol car turn around on them and pulled into the apartments on Thornton Ave. The driver exited and put himself in the prone position and put his hands behind his back. He admitted to breaking into the bank, setting a fire inside and outside of the bank due to some sort of conspiracy going on. The suspect advised he was trying to take out excess power to stop it. He also admitted to burning a vehicle on Elk St and to opening natural gas lines behind another business. He also admitted to attempting to set fire to a Norfolk Southern communication building on the tracks behind Wells Fargo. A book of burnt matches was located at this location.

### **July 2022 Crash Statistics**

In July 2022 there were 94 non-private property crashes reported. Total crashes, injury crashes, and total injuries decreased from June 2022. Rear end and angle crashes were the most prevalent during July 2022. Following too closely was the leading contributing factor in non-injury, while failure to yield was the leading contributing factor for injury crashes. Walnut Ave had the highest number of injury and non-injury crashes in July 2022.
