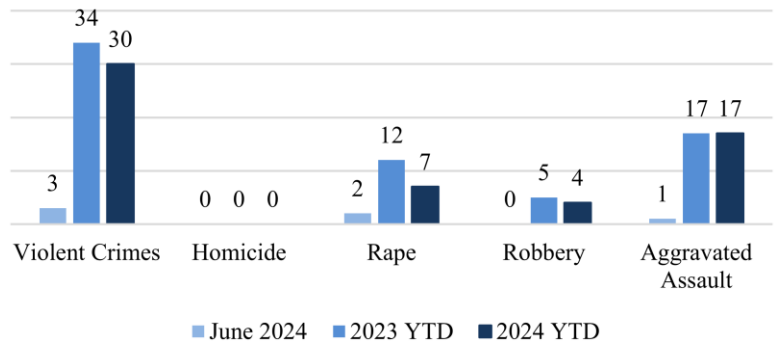

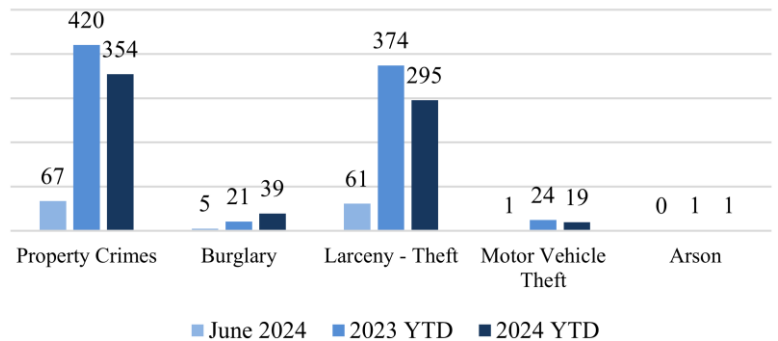

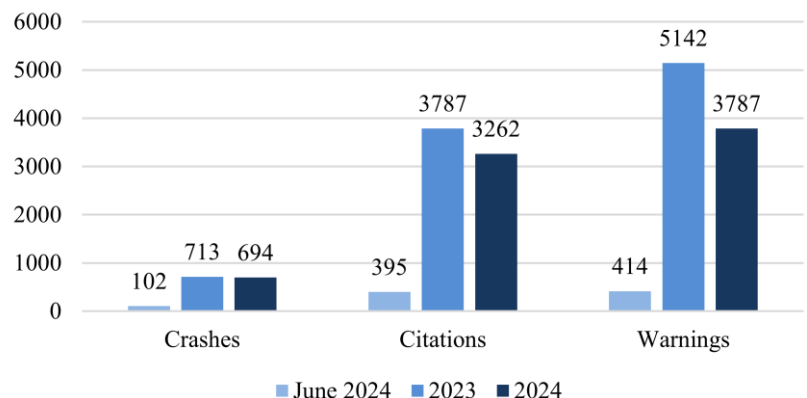

There were 70 Part 1 crimes in June 2024. That is an increase of approximately 22.8% compared to 57 in June 2023. Total Part 1 crimes YTD have decreased by approximately 15.42% when compared to 2023.

Violent crimes have decreased by approximately 11.76% when compared to 2023. There have been 30 violent crimes YTD compared to 34 in 2023.

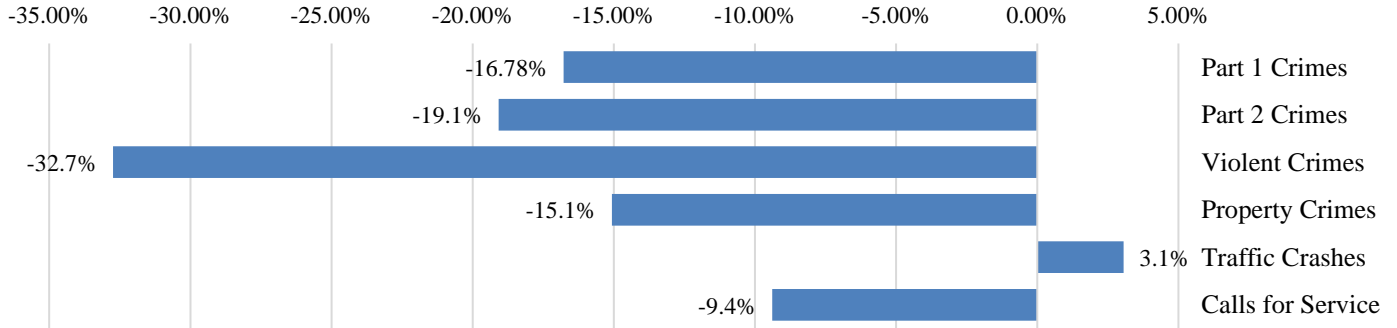
Property crimes have decreased by 15.71% when compared to 2023. Burglaries have increased significantly YTD compared to 2023 numbers.



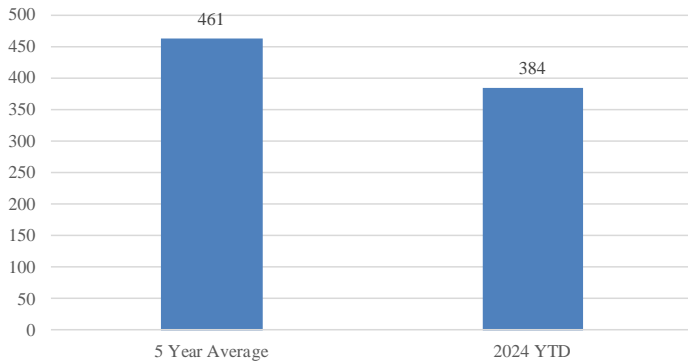
FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE

June 2024

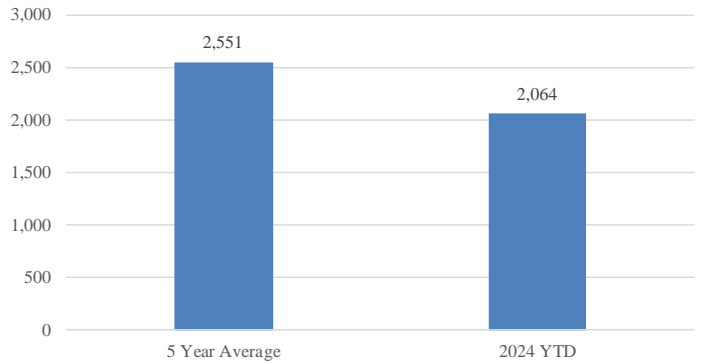
2024 YTD Compared to 5-Year Average



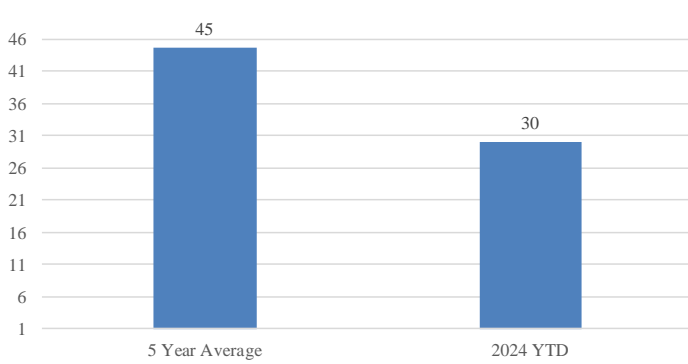

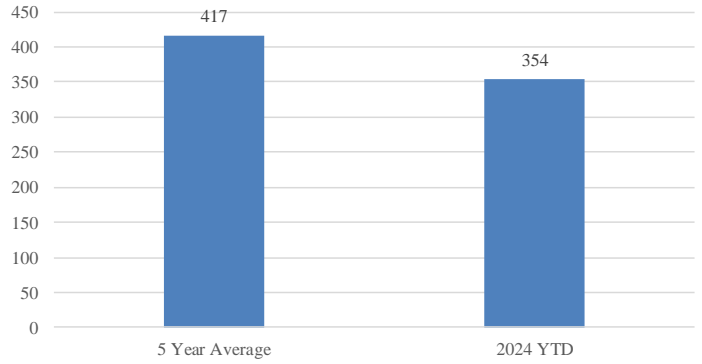
Part 2 Crimes



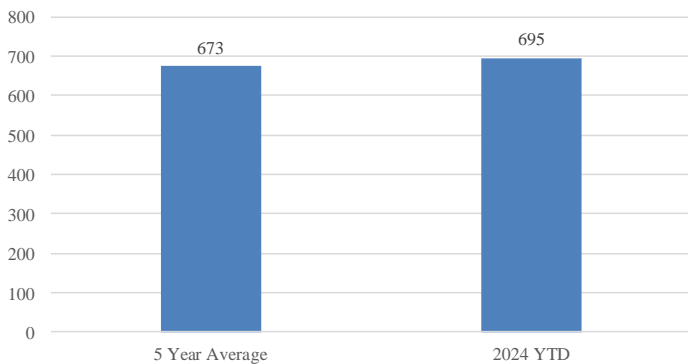

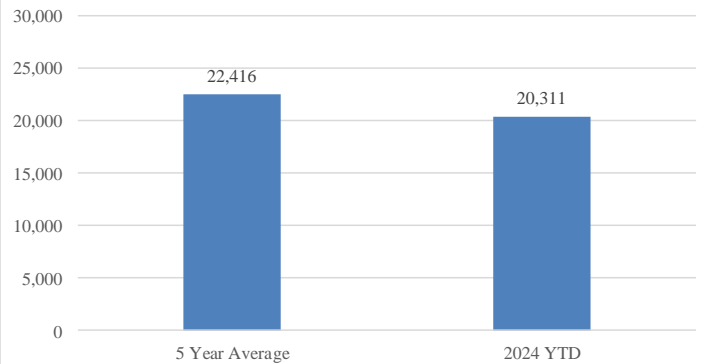

Traffic crashes decreased by approximately 13.6% when compared to May 2024. Year to date crashes have decreased by approximately 2.5%. Angle and rear end collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Walnut Ave had the highest number of crashes and injuries.
