Crime and Crash Statistics for May 2024

Assistant Police Chief Chris Crossen gave a written and oral summary of the Crime and Crash Statistical Reports for the month of May 2024. As noted in the written summary, Assistant Chief Crossen reported the Year to Date Part I crimes are approximately 18% lower, Part II crimes are approximately 32.3% lower, Violent crimes are approximately 21.1% lower, and Property Crimes are approximately 17.7% lower when compared to the past 5-year average. Assistant Chief Crossen further reported there were 118 non-private property crashes reported for the month and crashes decreased over the previous month.
