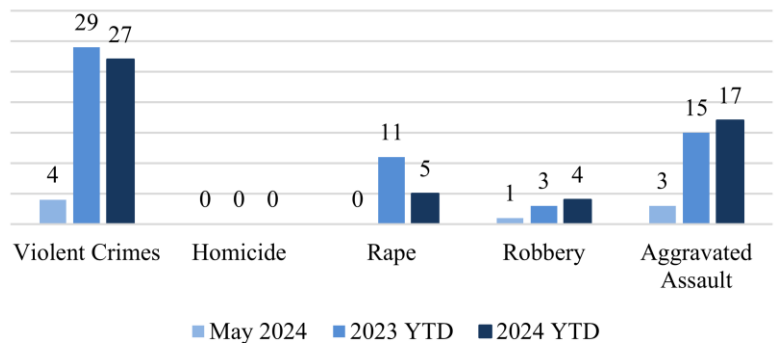

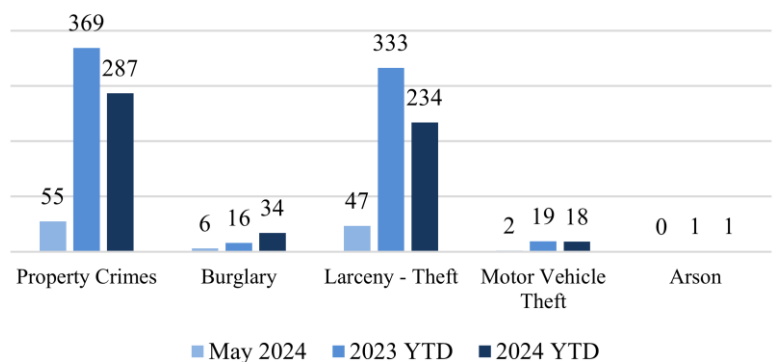

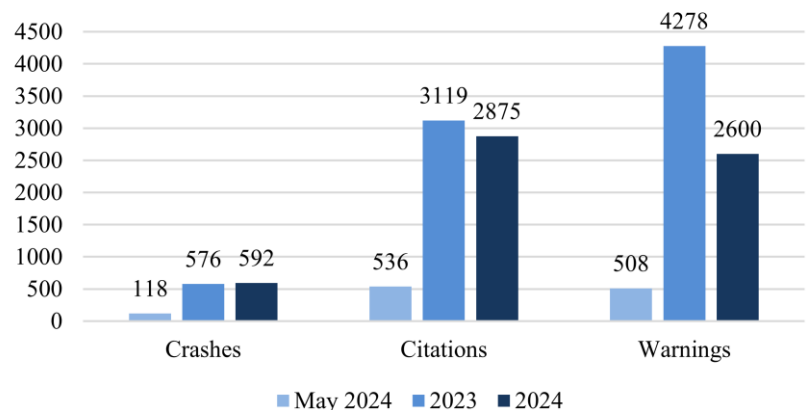

There were 59 Part 1 crimes in May 2024. That is a decrease of approximately 35.2% compared to 91 in May 2023. Total Part 1 crimes YTD have decreased by approximately 21.11% when compared to 2023.

Violent crimes have shown a slight increase YTD. There have been 27 violent crimes YTD compared to 29 in 2023. Aggravated assaults and robberies have slightly increased when compared to 2023.

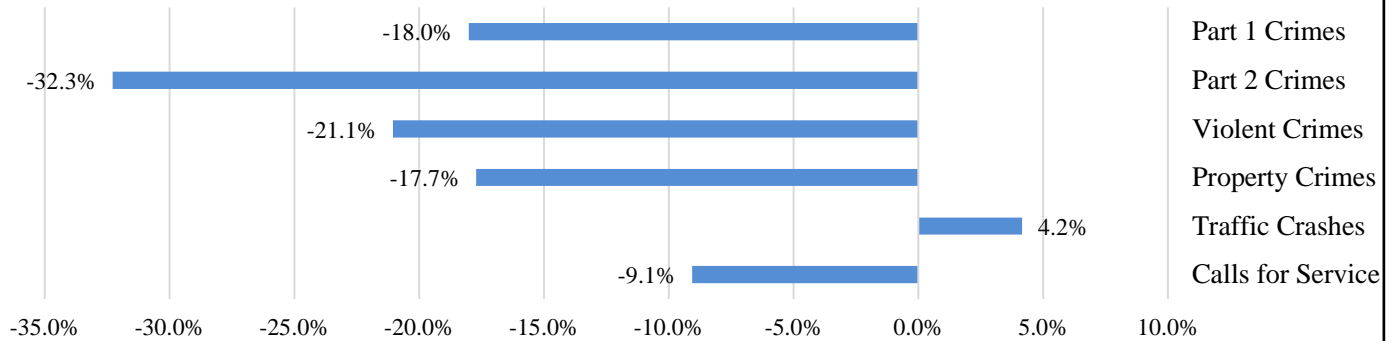
Property crimes have decreased by 22.22% when compared to 2023. Burglaries have increased significantly YTD compared to 2023 numbers.



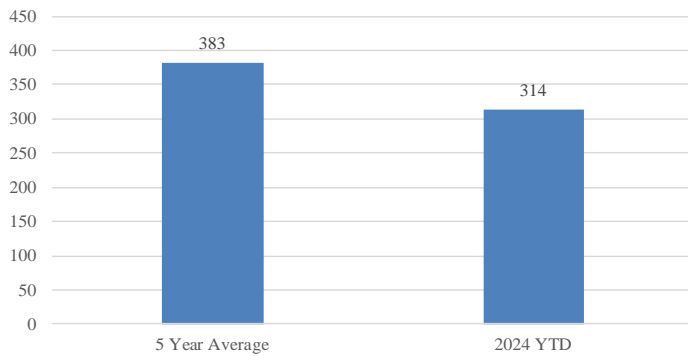
FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE

May 2024

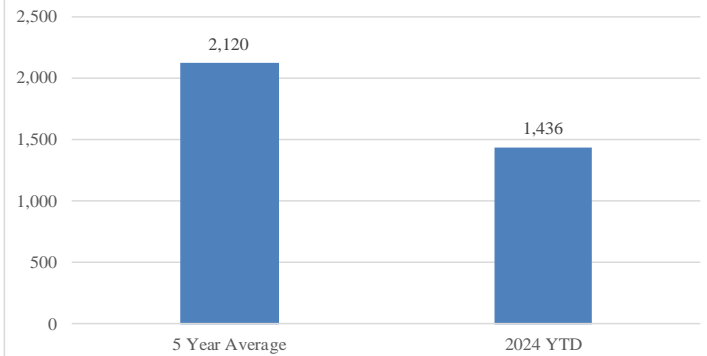
2024 YTD Compared to 5-Year Average



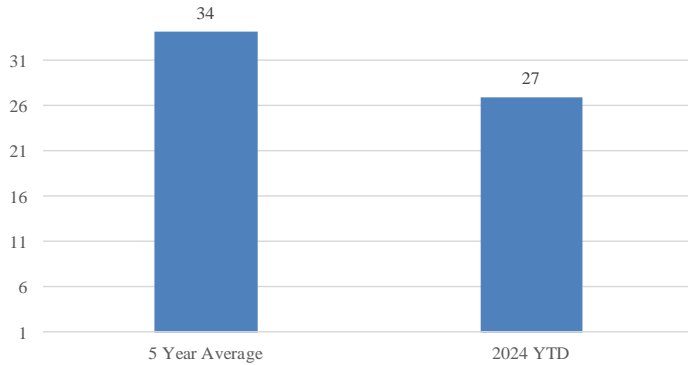

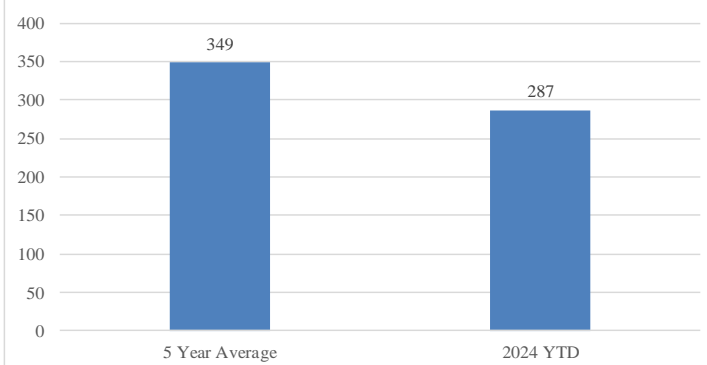
Part 2 Crimes



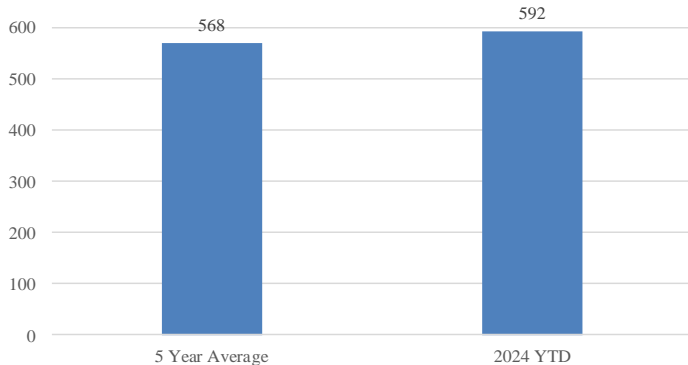

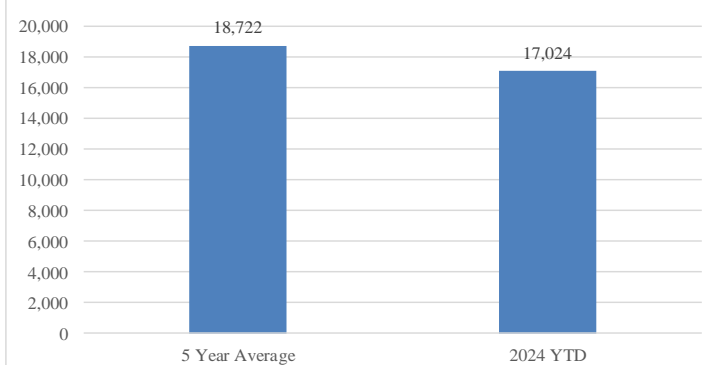

Traffic crashes decreased by approximately 4.8% when compared to April 2024. Year to date crashes have increased by approximately 2.8%. Angle and rear end collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Chattanooga Rd had the highest number of crashes and injuries.
