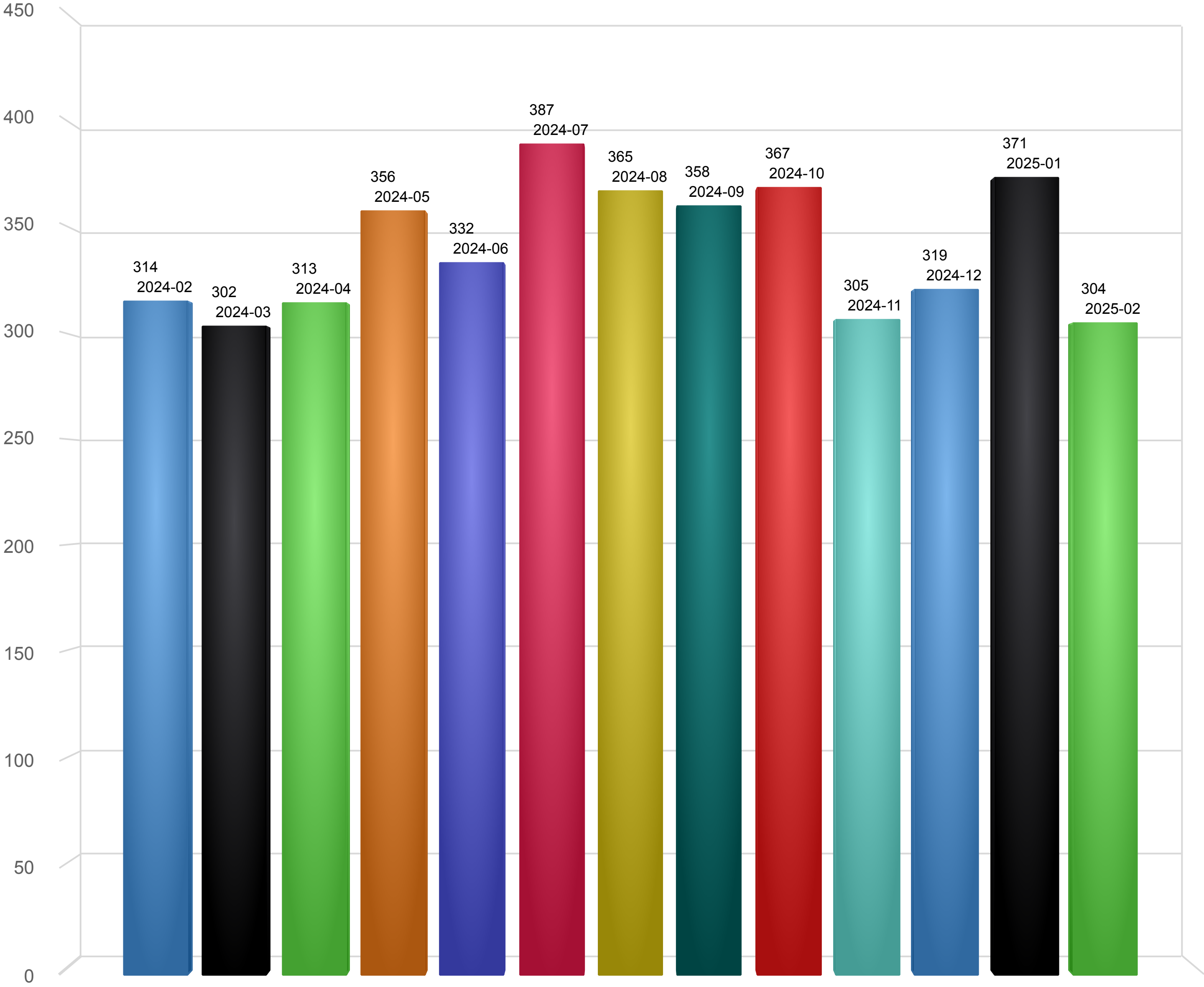

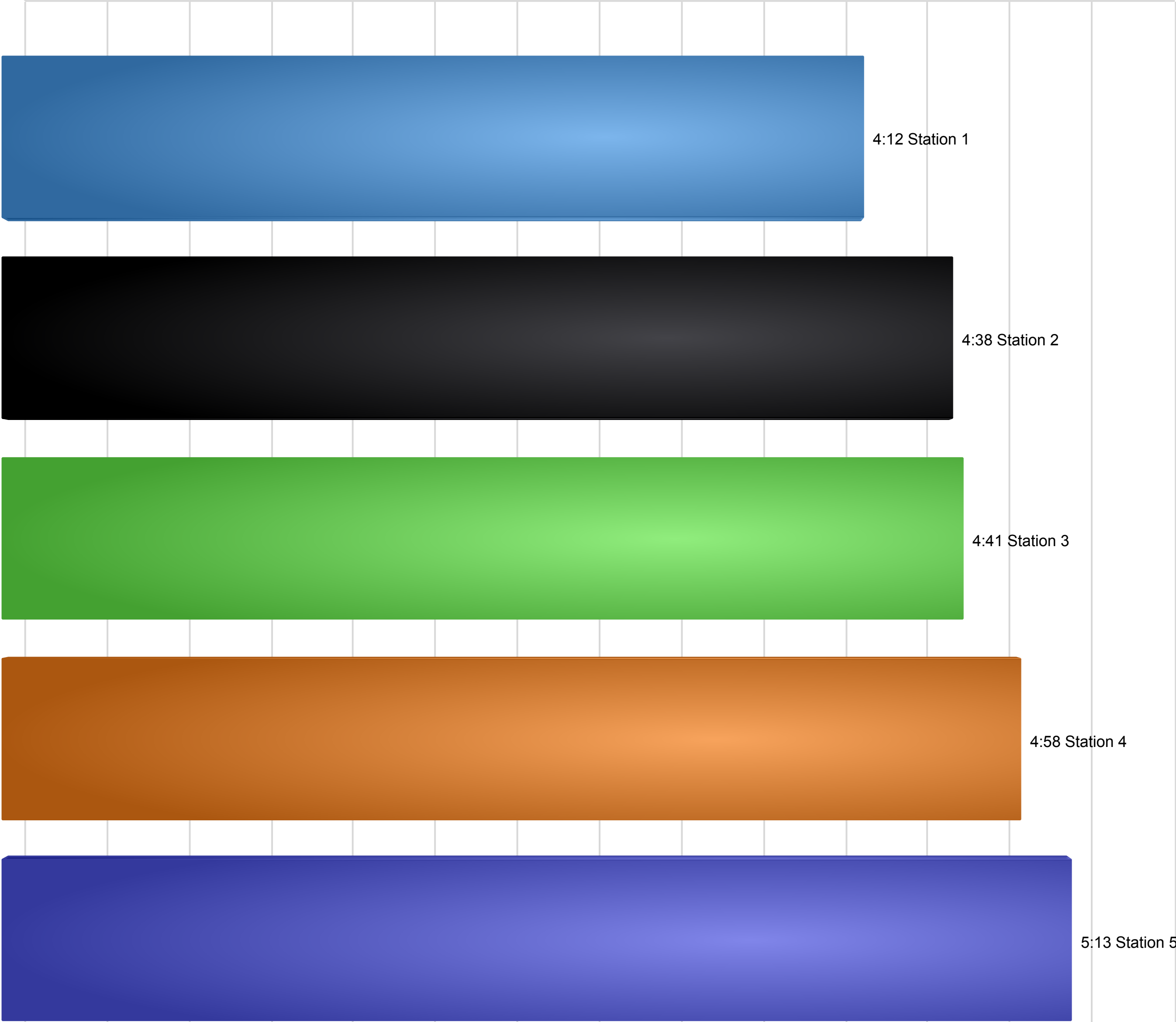

Response Time

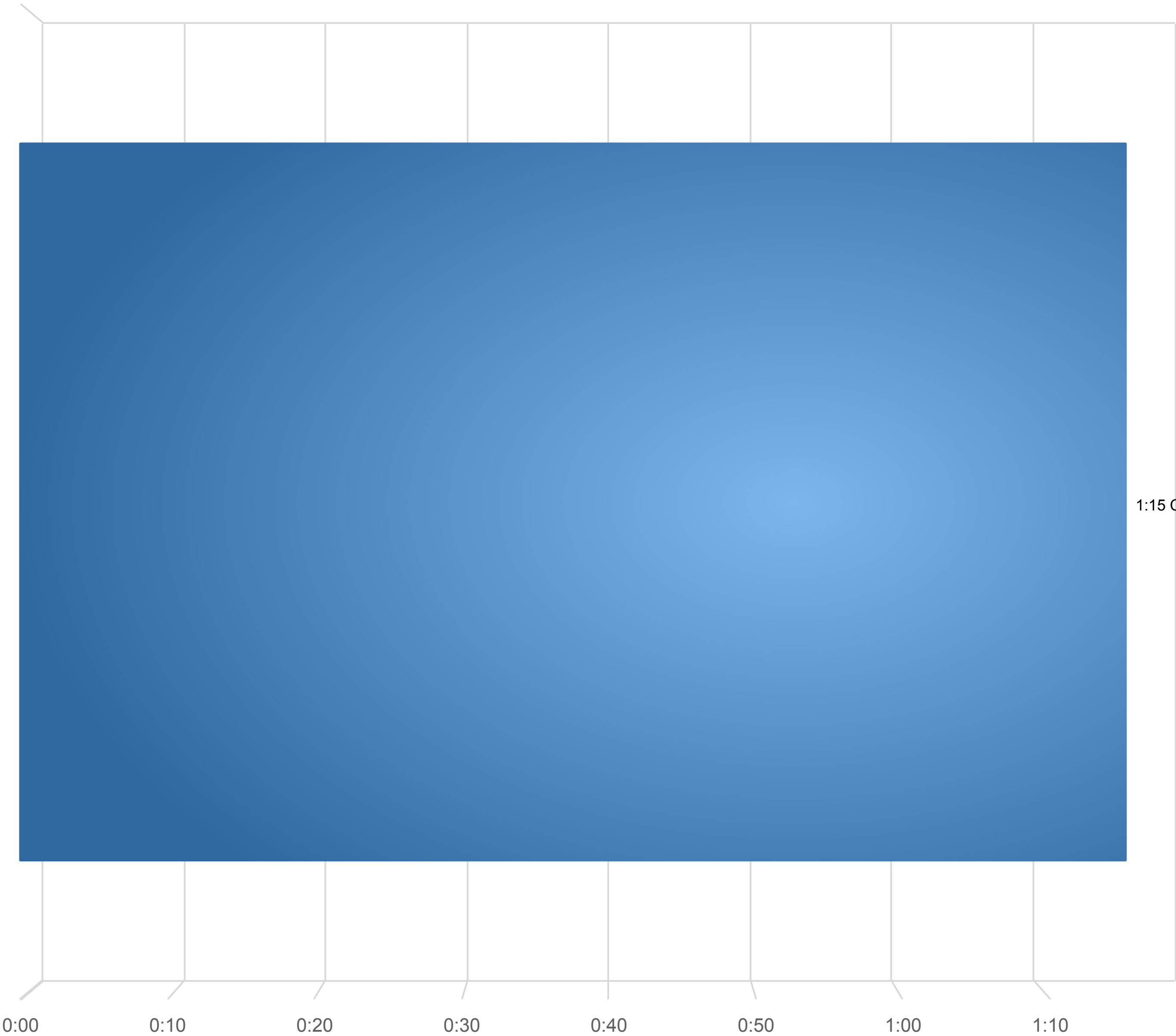

Travel Time

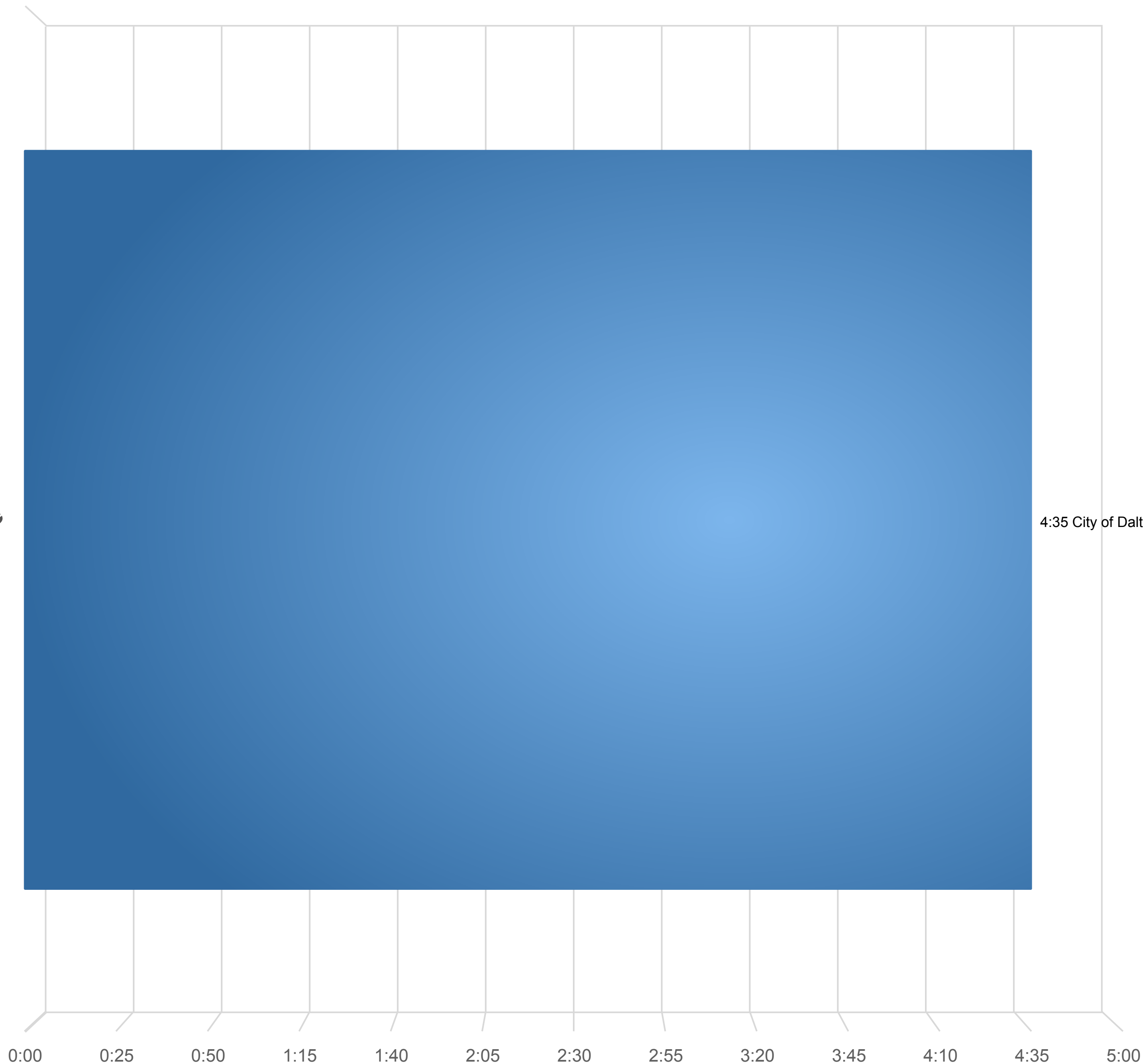

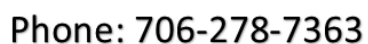
# Department Average Response Time (Alarm-> First Unit Arrival)

# **Training Division Monthly Report**

## **February 2025**

### **Overview**

The 2025 EMT/Paramedic recertification training was completed during the month for all licensed providers. This course is 40 hours in duration and is delivered over multiple weeks covering specified topic areas such as airway management, trauma, pediatrics, and cardiovascular emergencies. Members of B-shift completed a course titled The Nightclub Nightmare that explored the complications of fire incidents in high occupancy spaces. The Training Center played host to Georgia Smoke Diver Class #66 which produced 11 graduates from an original enrollment of 42 candidates. Monthly training included territory familiarization, core competency drills, special operations training, and company level drills chosen by company officers. Training hours during the month of February totaled 5,155.

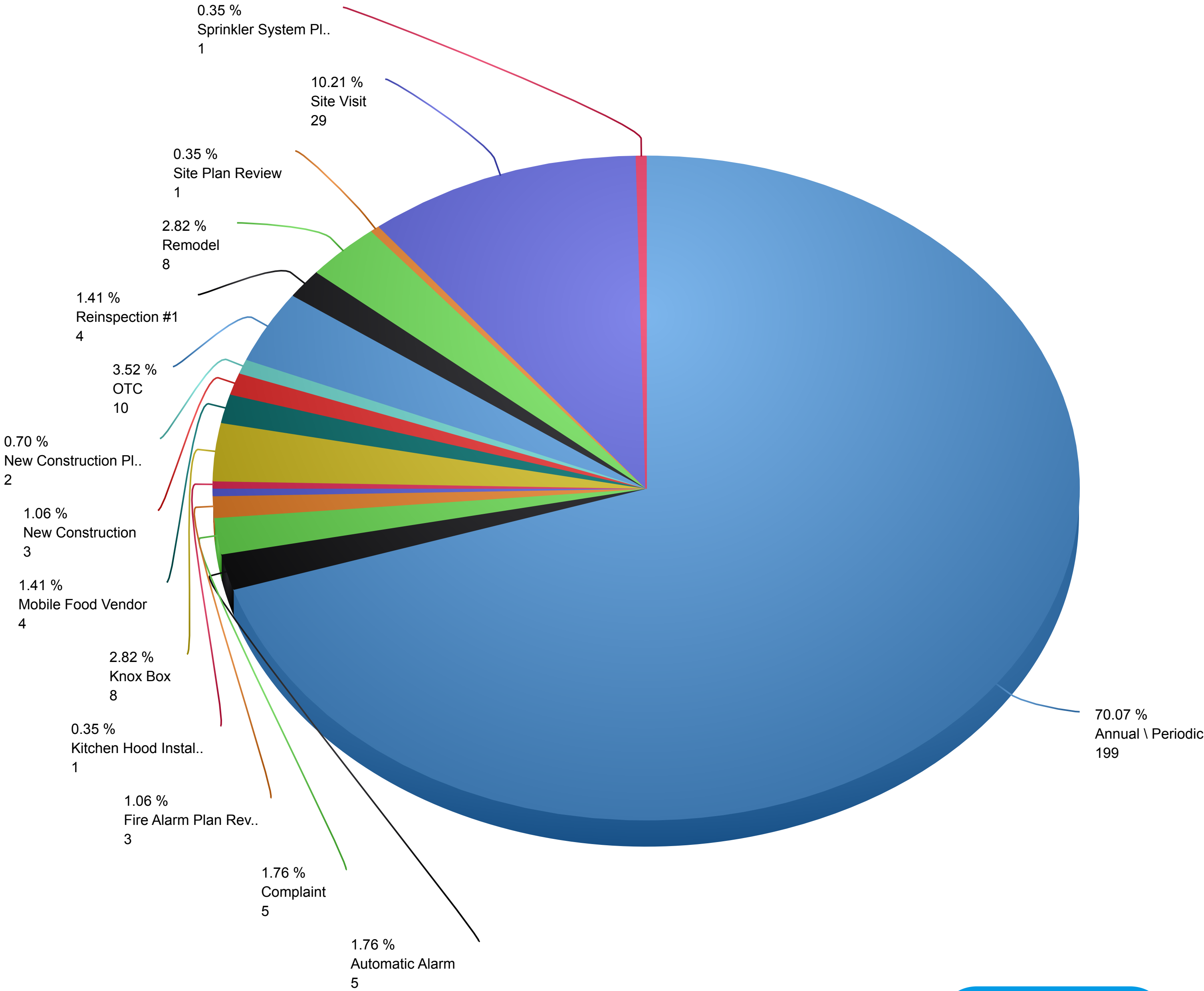
One inspector attended NPQ Fire Officer 1 at Dawson County Fire & Emergency Services.
