





Incidents by Months 04/01/2024-04/30/2025



Training Division Monthly Report April 2025

Overview

Internal continuing education for department members included Norfolk Southern Railroad Safety and Hazardous Materials class and the Night Club Nightmare mass gathering mass casualty class. Company-level training included ventilation and enlarged opening drills at acquired structures on Penrose Dr. and search and hose line deployment drills at acquired structures on East Walnut Ave. with Whitfield County Fire Department. The City of Dalton Residential Demolition Assistant Program facilitated training at these structures. Other company training included hazardous materials training, rapid intervention drills, area familiarization, and pre-fire planning. Training hours during the month of April totaled 2,988.
