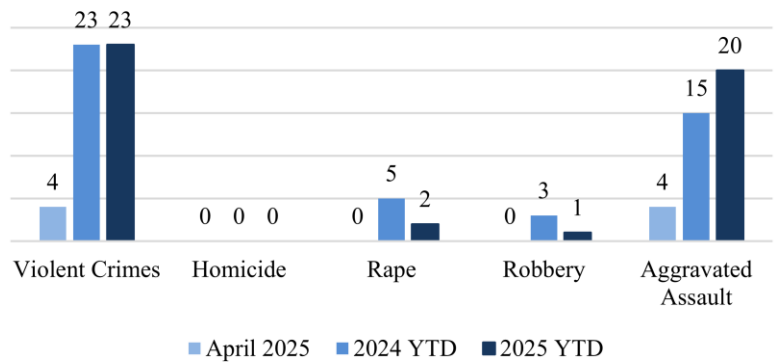

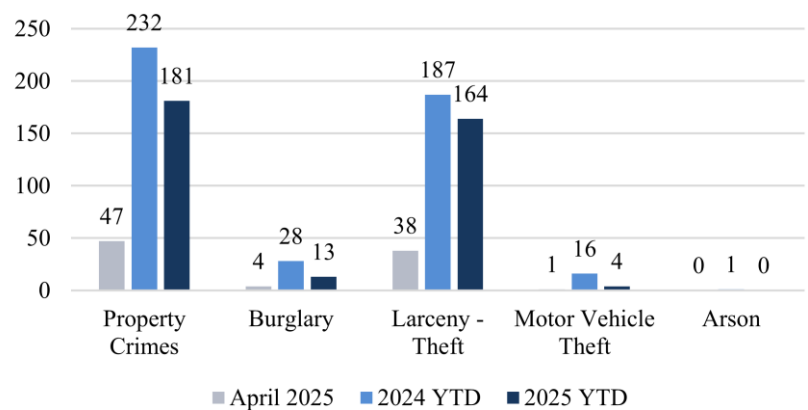

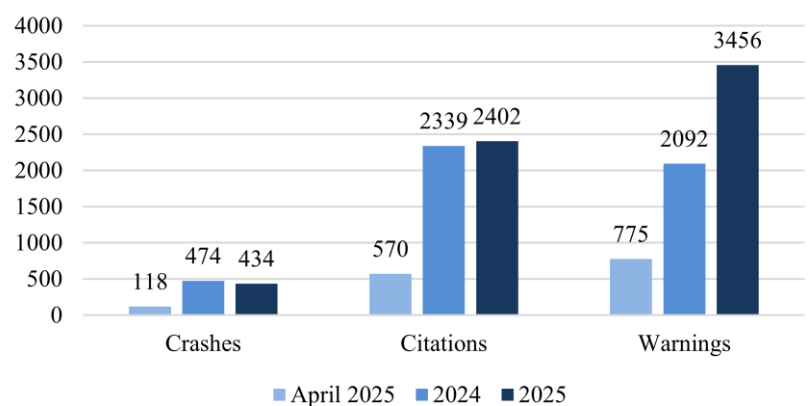

Violent crimes are the same when compared to 2024. There have been 23 violent crimes YTD 2025 compared to 23 in 2024.

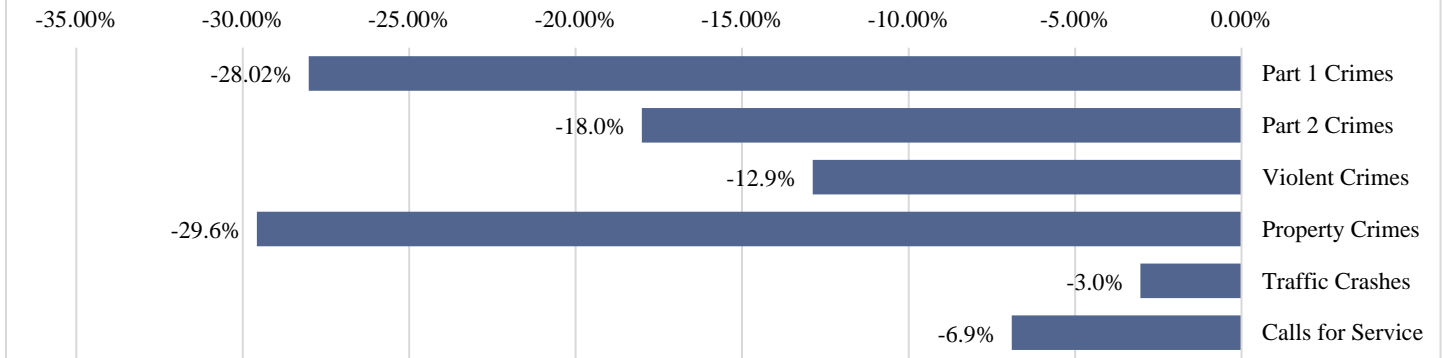
Property crimes have decreased by 21.98% when compared to 2024. All categories of property crimes have shown a decrease YTD compared to 2024.



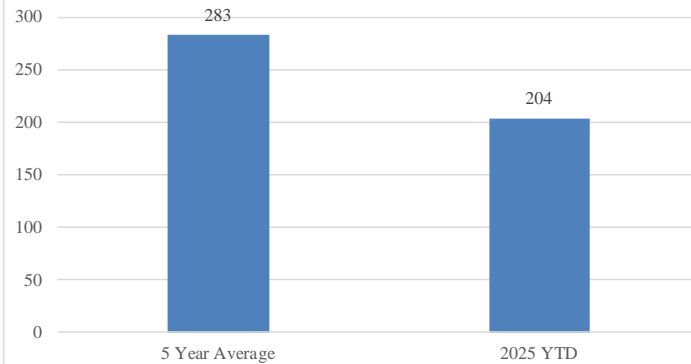
FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE

April 2025

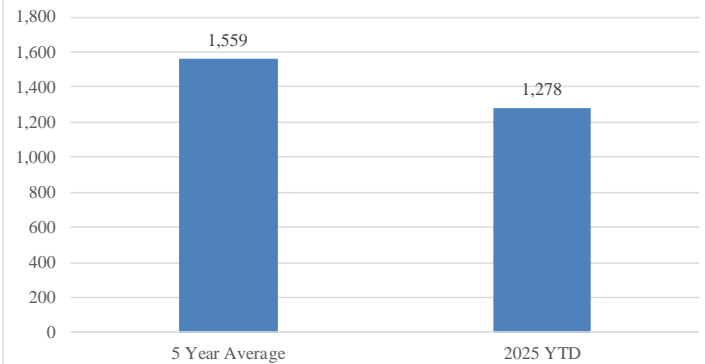
2025 YTD Compared to 5-Year Average



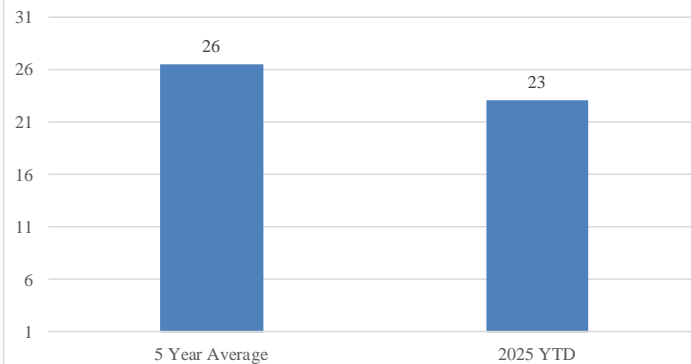

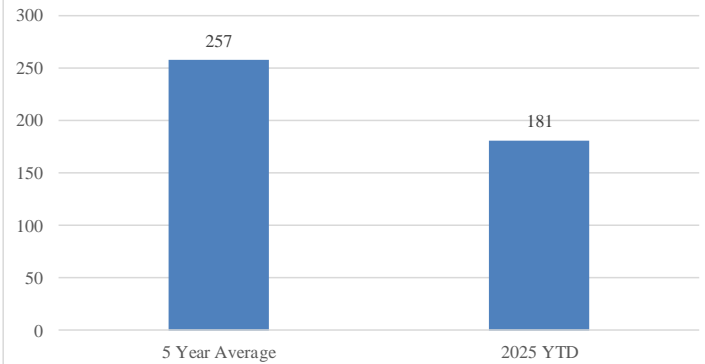

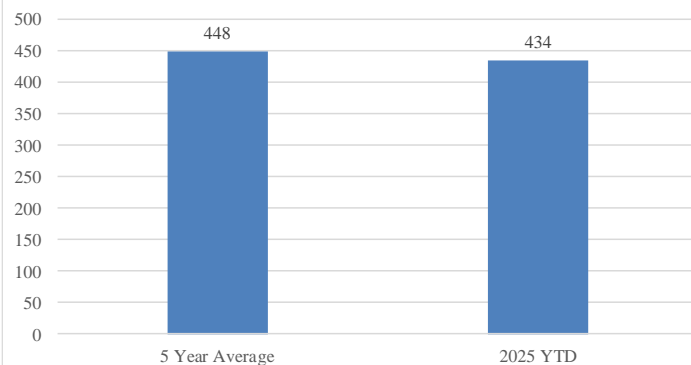

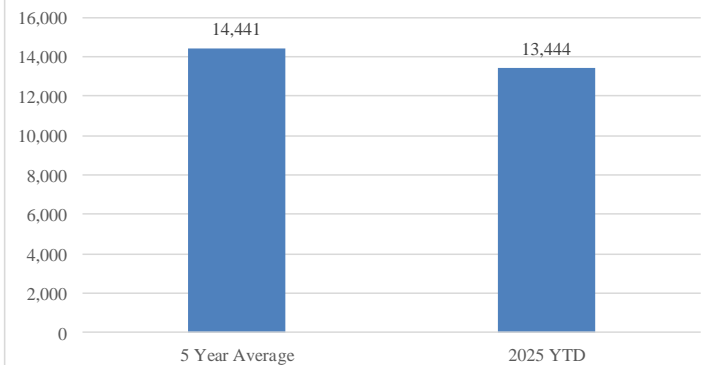

April 2025

Traffic crashes stayed the same when compared to March 2025. Year to date crashes have decreased by approximately 8.4%. Angle collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Walnut Ave had the highest number of crashes and injuries.
