

Training Division Monthly Report

September 2018

Overview

An awareness level course on surface water rescue was delivered to all suppression personnel. The Training Division conducted engine company drills in accordance with NFPA 1410 for all 15 crews assigned to engine companies within the city. Refresher training was completed for all personnel on basic and advanced forcible entry techniques. Additional monthly training included territory familiarization, pre-fire training, core competency check-offs, special operations training, and company level drills chosen by company officers. Training hours during the month of September totaled 2,033.
