SUMMARY OF DATA AND CRIME STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2020

General

Part 1 crimes have decreased approximately 18.4% when compared to year to date numbers from November 2019. Part 2 crimes also decreased by approximately 4.4% during the same time. Year to date calls for service are 8% higher than in 2019. Traffic crashes have decreased by approximately 18.1% when compared to year to date numbers from November 2019.

Trespassing offenses increased by approximately 42% in November 2020 compared to October 2020. Property damage offenses decreased by approximately 38% when compared to October 2020. Calls for service decreased by approximately 12% when compared to 2019. Citations showed a decrease of 30% compared to 2019 numbers.

Analysis

In the year to date 2020 there have been 854 Part 1 crimes reported versus 1047 in 2019 which shows an approximate decrease of 18.4%. Larceny-Theft crimes have decrease approximately 23.9% when compared to 2019 numbers.

There have been 90 violent crimes reported 2020 YTD compared to 85 reported violent crimes YTD 2019. Year to date property crimes have shown a decrease of approximately 21% when compared to 2019 YTD statistics.

Based on the statistics from the previous 5 years, property crime numbers are significantly lower than the normal range. Violent crime numbers are slightly lower than the 5 year average.

Aggravated Assault (FV)



November 2020 Crash Statistics

In November 2020 there were 99 non-private property crashes reported. Injury crashes and total injuries decreased when compared to October 2020. Rear end and angle crashes were the most prevalent during November 2020. Failure to yield and following too closely were the leading contributing factors in injury crashes. Following too closely was the leading contributing factor in non-injury crashes. Walnut Ave had the highest number of crashes in November 2020. Chattanooga Rd/N Bypass had the highest number of injuries during November 2020.



99 Crashes Reported in November 2020

- There were 24 less crashes in November 2020 than in October 2020.
 - 18 crashes reported in which injuries occurred.
 - That is one injury crash for every 5.5 crashes reported.
 - Multiple injuries were reported in 5 crashes.

 - 1 serious injury was reported.
 - 1 fatality was reported.
