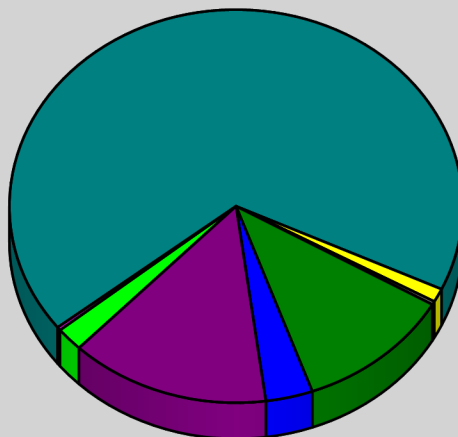

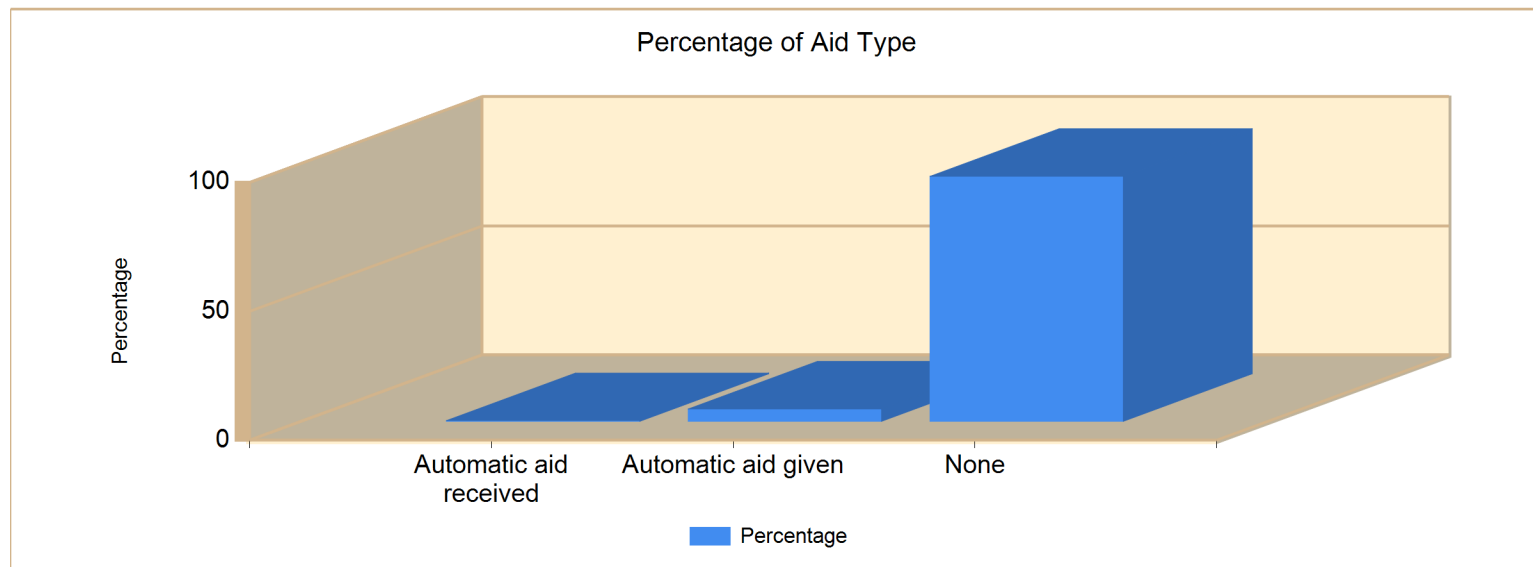

### **Overview**

Recruit Class 2021-01 continued throughout the month with 4 candidates enrolled. The department hosted Georgia Fire Academy's Structural Fire Control course at the training center. Monthly training included territory familiarization, pre-fire training, core competency check-offs, special operations training, and company level drills chosen by company officers. Training hours during the month of October totaled 2,429.
