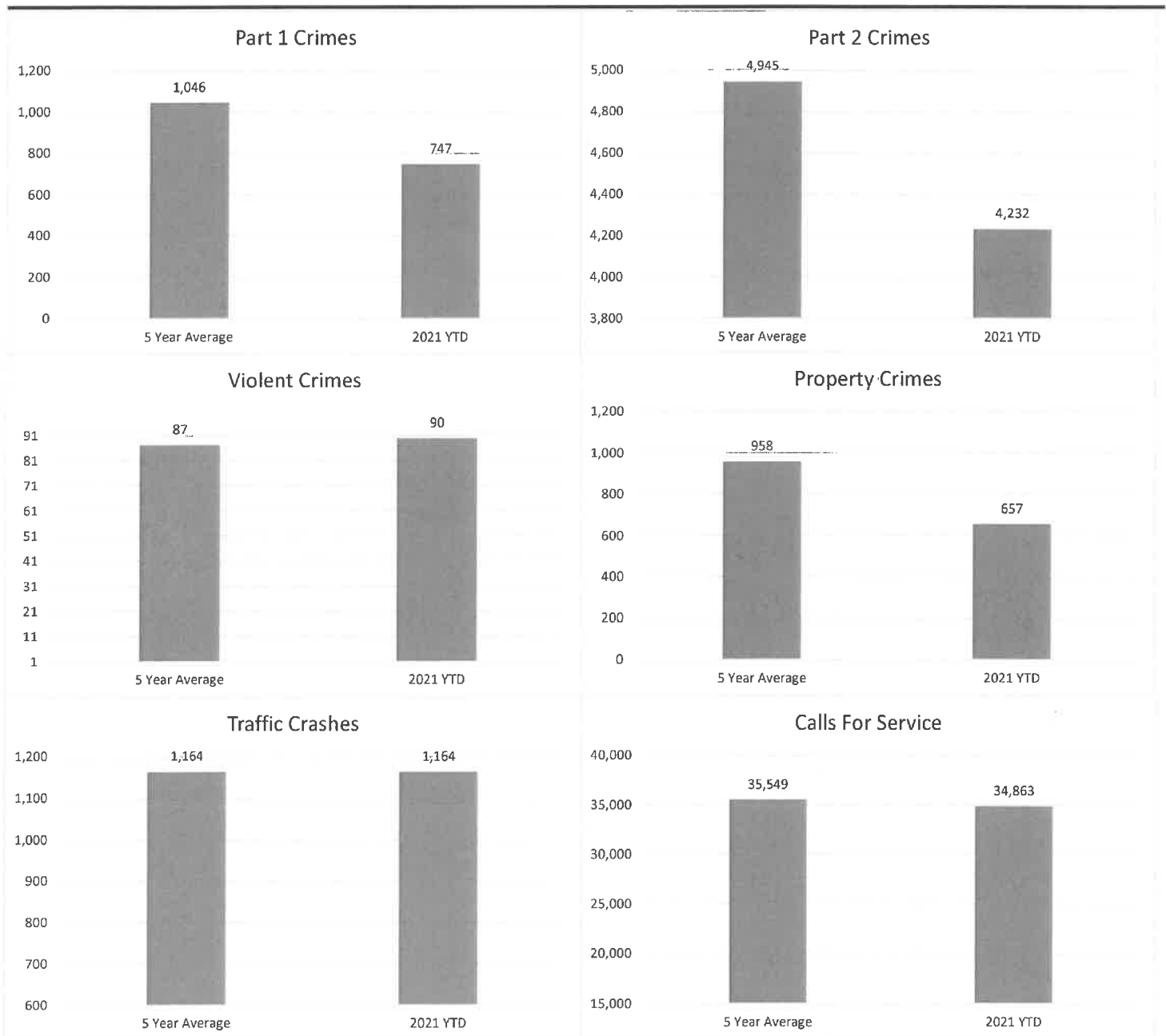


**DALTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

Summary of Data and Crime Statistics for October 2021

General

The following statistics compare 2021 year-to-date statistics with the five-year average prior to 2020. Part 1 crimes are approximately 28.6% lower than the five-year statistics. Part 2 crimes have decreased by approximately 15% during the same time. Property crimes show a decrease of approximately 31.4% from the five-year average. There have been 90 violent crimes year-to-date compared to the five-year average of 87. Traffic crashes are the same as the five-year average. Calls for service show a decrease of approximately 1.9% during the same time.

Analysis

In the year to date 2021 there have been 747 Part 1 crimes reported, which is approximately 4.2% lower than 2020. Motor vehicle thefts have increased significantly since last year, although total property crime numbers are down.

There have been 90 violent crimes reported 2021 YTD compared to 84 reported violent crimes YTD 2020. There have been eight robberies reported in 2021 compared to seventeen last year. Year to date property crimes have shown a decrease of approximately 5.6% when compared to 2020 YTD statistics.

Based on the statistics from the previous five years, property crime numbers are lower than the average. Violent crime numbers are slightly above the five-year average of 87.8.

Summary of Significant Events for October 2021

21-006469	Aggravated Assault	1420 Burgess Dr
<p>The victim reported her boyfriend used a hand gun to break out the window of the front door to the apartment, and began waving the gun around making threats to kill her. Prior to officer's arrival the suspect fled the area in a grey passenger vehicle. A patrol officer was able to locate the vehicle near Waugh St and Thornton Ave and attempted a traffic stop. The vehicle continued traveling at normal speed and made no evasive action until it ran the red light at Trammell St, at which point the patrol officer discontinued the stop. A different officer was in the area of Shugart Rd and observed the vehicle get stuck in traffic at the red light. The officer was able to contact the suspect and detained him until other units arrived. The suspect was removed from the vehicle and arrested. He was charged with multiple charges including aggravated assault and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.</p>

October 2021 Crash Statistics

In October 2021 there were 152 non-private property crashes reported. Injury crashes increased from 18 in September 2021 to 37 in October 2021. Angle and rear end crashes were the most prevalent during October 2021. Failure to yield was the leading contributing factor in injury crashes. Following too closely was the leading contributing factor in non-injury crashes. Walnut Ave had the highest number of crashes and injuries.
