

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Training Division Monthly Report

April 2021

Overview

The department hosted a field maintenance technician course delivered by Draeger that trained 8 members of the hazardous materials team to perform maintenance and calibration functions on all of the department's atmospheric monitors. All licensed EMTs and Paramedics completed a course on COVID-19 vaccine administration. The department hosted a 4-day instructor development course conducted by the Georgia Smoke Diver Association. Monthly training included territory familiarization, pre-fire training, core competency check-offs, special operations training, and company level drills chosen by company officers. Training hours during the month of April totaled 2,753.

Outside Schools

2 firefighters attended Georgia Fire Academy's Pressurized Container Fire Control hosted by Gordon County Fire Rescue.

7 personnel completed Georgia Fire Academy's Pressurized Container Fire Control Instructor course hosted by Gordon County Fire Rescue.

4 members of the department's Special Operations Team attended Swiftwater Rescue Technician – Levels 1 & 2 at the U.S. National Whitewater Center in Charlotte, North Carolina.

2 of the department's fire investigators attended Georgia Fire Investigator's Association Spring Seminar in Helen, Georgia.

1 of the department's paramedics completed Level 1 EMS Instructor training delivered by the National Association of Emergency Medical Service Educators.


