There were 40 Part 1 crimes in December 2025. That is a decrease of approximately 32.2% compared to 59 in December 2024. Total Part 1 crimes YTD have decreased by approximately 18.85% when compared to 2024. Total Part 1 crimes for 2025 are approximately 31.77% lower than the 5-year average.


Violent crimes have decreased by approximately 4.35% when compared to 2024. There have been 66 violent crimes YTD 2025 compared to 69 violent crimes in 2024. Homicides and aggravated assaults have increased since last year. The 5-year average for violent crimes is 87 crimes. Current violent crime numbers are lower than 2024, and are approximately 24.0% lower than the 5-year average.

Property crimes have decreased by 20.32% when compared to 2024. All categories of property crimes have shown a decrease YTD compared to 2024. Current property crime numbers are approximately 32.6% lower than the 5-year average.

## December 2025

Traffic crashes decreased by approximately 8.3% when compared to November 2025. Year to date crashes have decreased by approximately 6.8%. Rear end collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Chattanooga Rd had the highest number of crashes and injuries during November.
