AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 62-162 OF CHAPTER 62 THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF DICKINSON, NORTH DAKOTA, RELATING TO ZONING TEXT AMENDMENTS FOR THE SIZE OF AGRICULTURALLY ZONED LOTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF DICKINSON, NORTH DAKOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 62-162 of Chapter 62 of the City Code of the City of Dickinson is hereby amended and re-enacted as follows:
