## **Background & Description**

The City of Dickinson (Sponsor) requests cost-share for the NW Regional Pond Feasibility Study (Project). With the release of FEMA's latest Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), more than 750 properties are now within the floodplain. Many of these properties are concentrated along the Dickinson Drainageway. The Project's purpose is to mitigate flood risks at the headwaters of the Dickinson Drainageway. The first phase of the project is a feasibility study to determine the benefits and costs of a controlled pond system designed to manage and regulate high-flow events. The Project will include modeling, alternative analysis, concept design, cost estimating, and a summary feasibility report. The Project is northwest of the City of Dickinson in Stark County, North Dakota.
