Under general direction of Public Works Director, this position will direct, plan, develop, implement and coordinate services, programs, and environmental activities related to stormwater compliance, industrial and commercial wastewater compliance, water quality compliance, solid waste compliance, air quality compliance, ~~recycling and conservation programs~~; coordinate assigned activities with other City departments, divisions, and outside agencies; provide highly responsible and complex staff assistance to the Public Works Department; and act as project manager on assigned projects.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Essential Duties:

- ~~Sets precedent within limits and/or administers operating rules and procedures under management guidance, which affects a medium sized work unit, less than 10% of the organization, with moderate financial impact.~~
- ~~Review and interpretation of local, state, and federal regulations.~~
- ~~Performs advanced troubleshooting or analysis; uses judgment to select from multiple known alternatives.~~
- Plan, develop, implement, and coordinates and administers the services and activities relating to Public Works Department and City wide environmental issues and concerns programs and projects, and ensures ongoing regulatory compliance, including water quality monitoring and enforcement, stormwater management, pollutant discharge monitoring, industrial pretreatment program, and solid and hazardous waste support; monitors conditions and activity for meeting compliance standards and submits regulatory documents.
- Participate in the development and implementation of goals, objectives, policies, and priorities for assigned services and programs; recommend and implement policies, procedures and standard operating procedures to enhance operational efficiency and effectiveness.
- Oversees stormwater management program and ensures standards comply with federal, state and local regulations; complies, prepares and submits water quality reports to governmental agencies.
- Assists in planning, developing, and implementing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) policies and procedures; oversees and administers industrial pretreatment program and ensures compliance with federal, state, and local rules and regulations.
- ~~Oversee, direct and review the work of assigned technical staff and/or outside consultants; ensure that projects are in conformance with appropriate departmental and City rules, regulations, and policies as well as appropriate local, state and federal laws and regulations.~~
- ~~Coordinate the services and activities of the Public Works Department to ensure environmental compliance with state and federal regulations; related to water quality, stormwater, pretreatment, and disposal of contaminated material.~~
- Participates in agency inspections and site reviews.
- Participate in the development and implementation of goals, objectives, policies, and priorities for assigned services and programs; identify resource needs; recommend and implement policies and procedures related to solid waste handling and disposal, City MS4, industrial pretreatment, and FOG programs.

- Receives, investigates and ~~Responds to~~ and resolve difficult and sensitive citizen complaints, inquiries and ~~complaints~~ requests for services.
- Assists with preparation and development of the environmental compliance program, stormwater, and industrial pretreatment program budgets.
- Assists in preparing and monitoring grants and related proposals for assigned programs.
