

The City of Dickinson received bids to provide routine maintenance and inspections to the 33 stationary generators and 2 portable generators. A total of 3 bids were received and review by city staff. It is the recommendation of City Staff to award the Generator Maintenance Agreement to TW Enterprises for a 3-year period (paid annually as described below) with the option to extend to 5-years if both parties agree.

The scope of the project includes:

- Routine service inspections
- Annual service to generators and auto transfer switches
- Onsite repair and replacement of minor issues during inspections
- Priority scheduling of major repairs
- Load testing and power transfer on designated units
- Programming as needed
