RE: SCADA Services Agreement with ENETK

This is an agreement between the City of Dickinson and ENETK LLC to provide a new SCADA system for the City's water and wastewater infrastructure including the Water Reclamation Facility, lift stations, and distribution network. SCADA is a vital piece of our utility infrastructure and provides remote monitoring and control of pumps, valves, and other components. Our current SCADA systems are outdated and have become unreliable.

We were pleased to see a variety of responses to the RFP posted on June 25, 2025. The unexpectedly large number of proposals received caused the evaluation and selection of respondents to take longer than expected, and we would like to thank Engineering staff for their assistance in the scoring and interview process for this RFP.

ENETK LLC is headquartered in Dickinson, which will provide a significant reduction in potential downtime for service after the SCADA system is in place.

Below is an itemized estimate of project costs provided by ENETK:

Labor	\$52,932 - \$65,250
Material	\$10,000 - \$23,000
Software	\$66,498.67
Total	\$129,430 - \$154,748

The agreement has been reviewed by City staff and Attorney Wenko. It is staff recommendation to approve the agreement with ENETK LLC.
