Consideration to Approve



- Amends Section 6-39
- Removes “unattended” language from the Code
- Allows City to cite animal owners for nuisance noise violations when owner is in presence of animal

It is an ~~unattended~~ animal that exhibits loud and frequent yelping, barking, crying or howling outside of the dwelling that disturbs a reasonable person of ordinary sensibilities.
