Background & Description

The City of Dickinson is requesting construction cost-share for their 5th Street SE (Project). The Project is installation of approximately 800 feet of water main along 5th Street SE between Highlands Avenue and 6th Avenue SE to extend and loop the distribution system. The Project is part of a combined street replacement, sanitary sewer, and water supply infrastructure improvements in Dickinson. The Project is located in Stark County.
