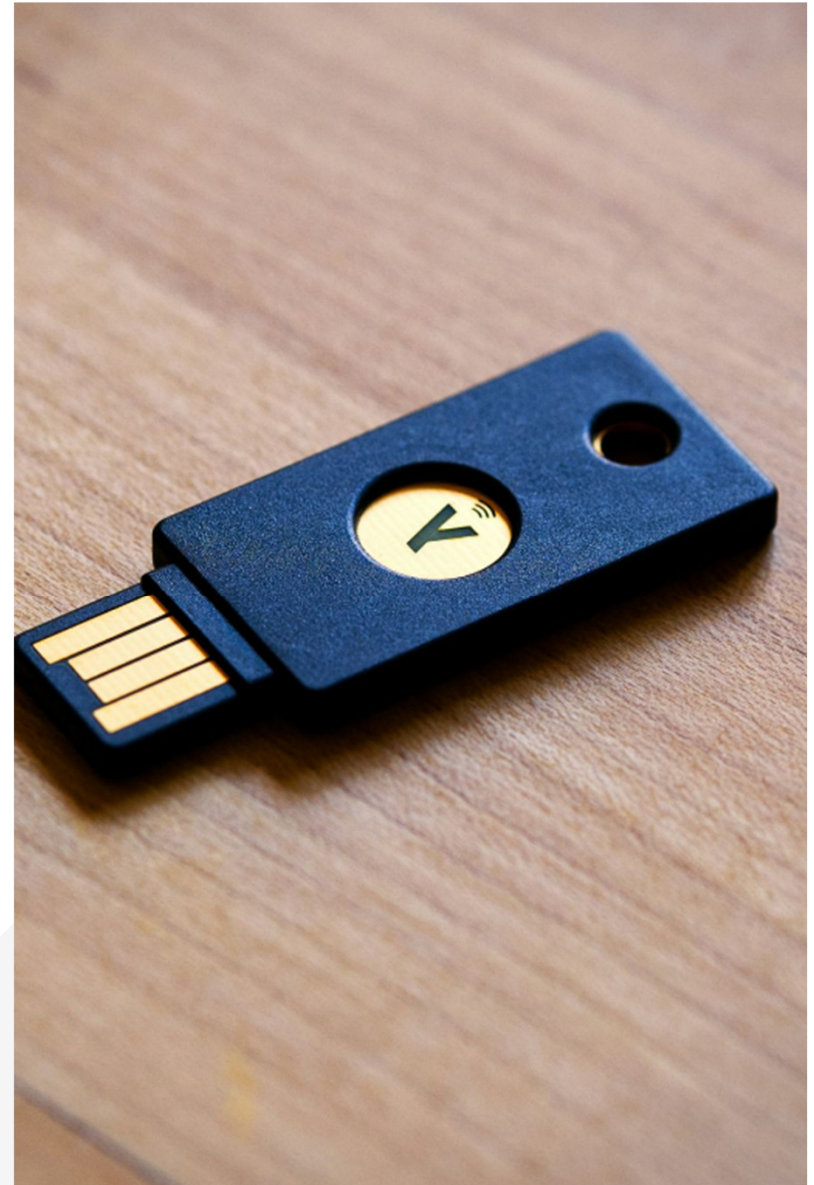


Cybersecurity Grants

Public Library Updates

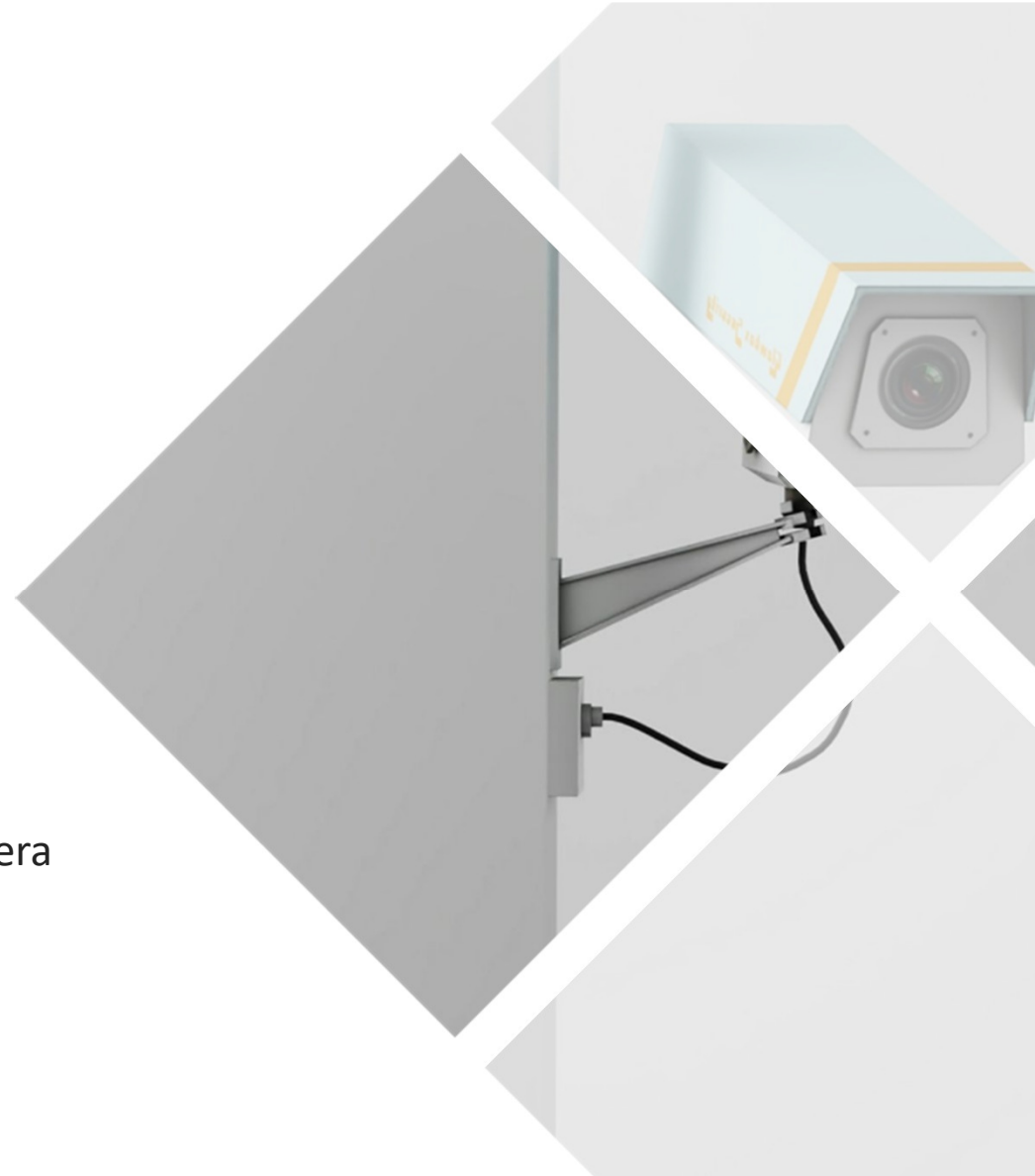
- ◆ 25 Lab Units

PSC Camera Updates

- Updated Camera Systems at PSC
- Old System was installed in 2015
- Replaced 16 Cameras
- Added 5 Cameras
- 4 In Evidence
- 1 In Med Storage for EMS
- Migrated Dispatch to Wall Display for Camera Monitoring





Dispatch Support Services

- Took over Support of Dispatch
- Migrated equipment to City Network
- Provide 24/7/365 Support
- Based on \$5,000 Contract with County



Purchased IT Cargo Van

- ◆ Purchased 2021 Dodge Promaster
- ◆ Outfitted the Van with Shelving
- ◆ Spent ~\$35,500 on Van

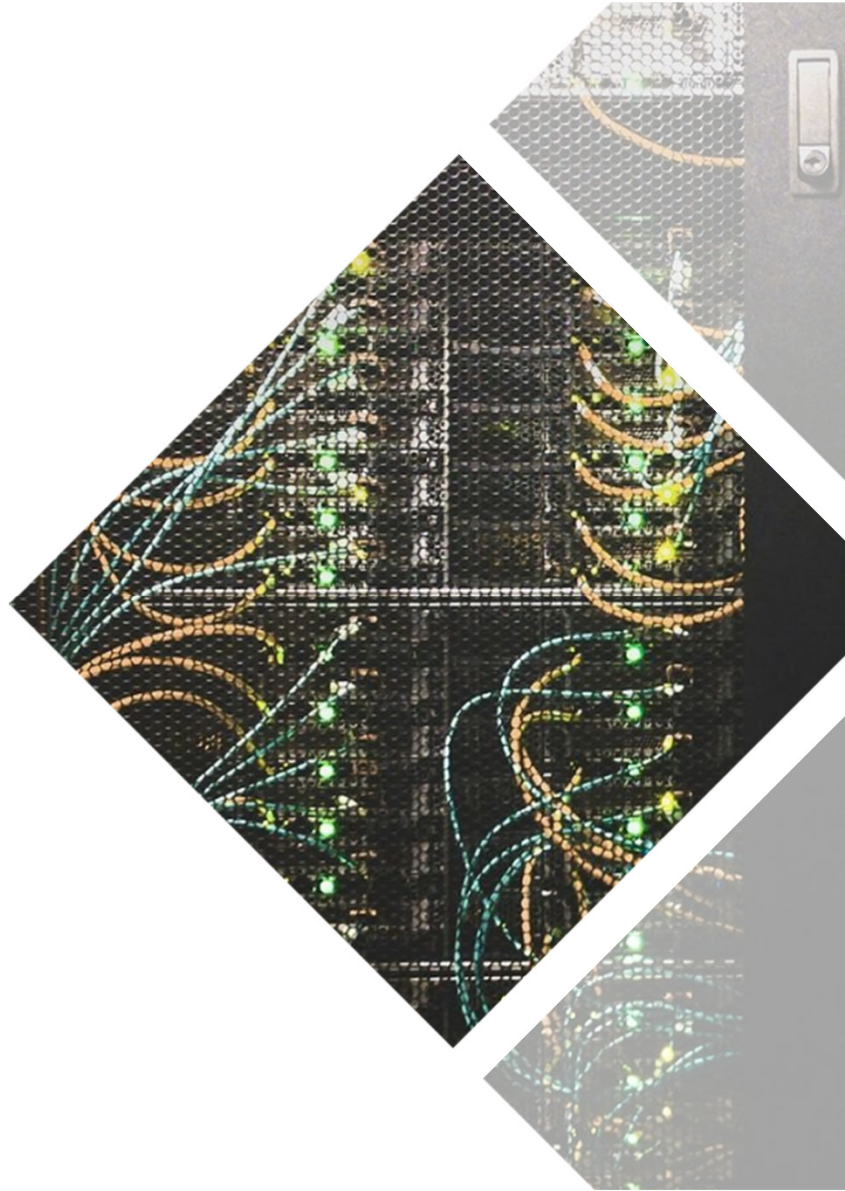
- ◆ Utilized for Project Installs across the City allowing IT a mobile workspace and storeroom





Hyper-V Host Server Replacement Project

- ◆ Utilized Grant Funding to Cover 2/3 Servers
- ◆ Hardware Cluster that supports 90% of the City's Virtual Infrastructure





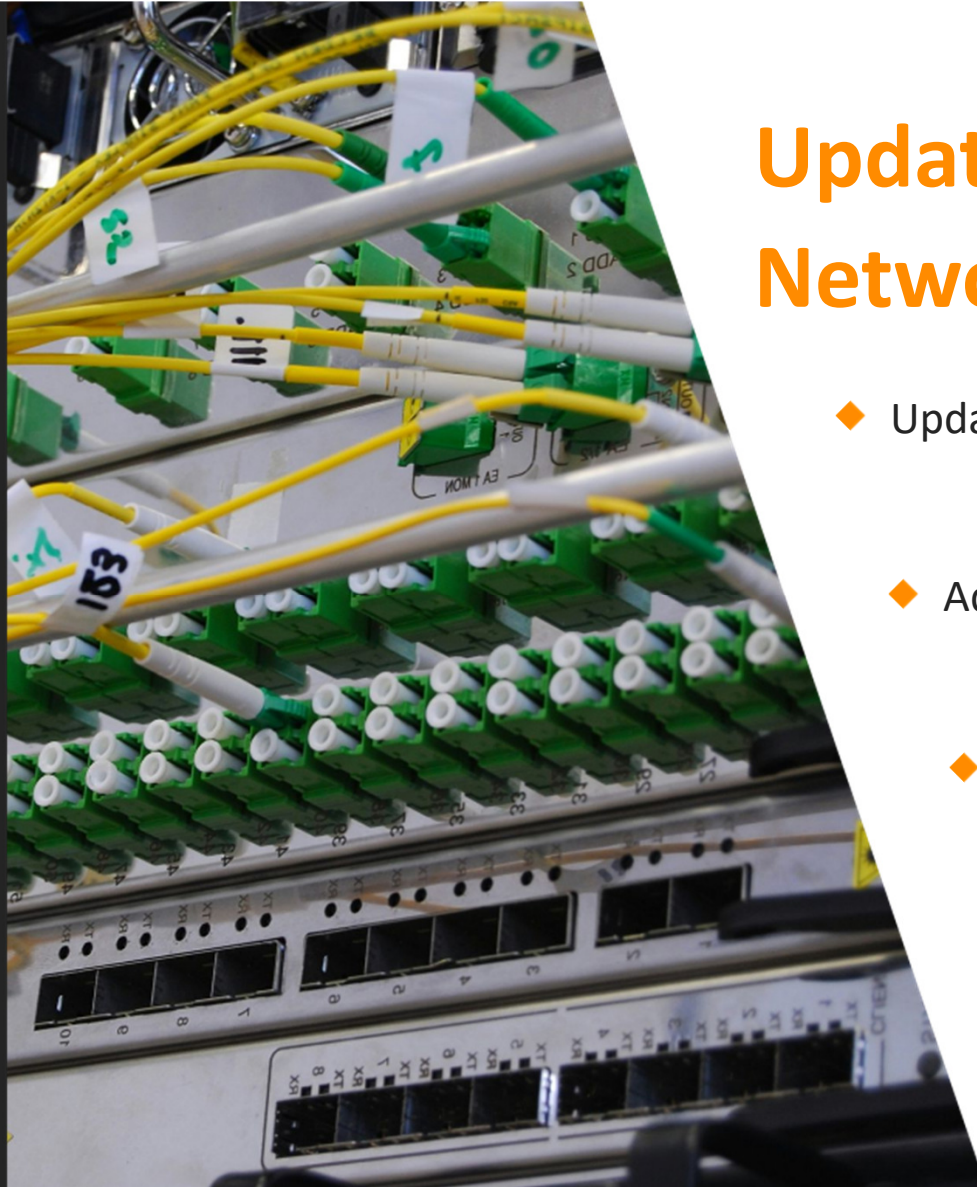
HITACHI SAN Project

Partially Funded by Federal & State Grants

Provides Storage for City Server Infrastructure

Project Provides for a full replica in our secondary server room allowing for greater cyber resiliency





Updates to the Fiber Network

- ◆ Updated Connectivity between Museum and City Hall
- ◆ Added Fiber to the Pioneer Machinery Building
- ◆ Updated Connectivity from Server Room to Network Room to Support Virtual Cluster



User Multi-Factor Authentication Project

- ◆ Grant Supported Initiative to enhance user security
- ◆ Rolled Out to Users over a 5 week period
- ◆ Requires utilization of a security token - Phone/Hardware/App to authenticate
