

FIRE PREVENTION


The City of Dickinson Fire Department provides Fire Prevention and Public Education Services.



INCIDENTS BY TYPE



Fires

Any uncontrolled burning incident, including structure fires, vehicle fires, and wildland fires.



Rescue & Emergency Medical Service (EMS)

Incidents involving the rescue of individuals and medical emergencies.



Hazardous Condition (No Fire)

Situations involving hazardous materials, gas leaks, or electrical hazards.



Service Call

Non-emergency assistance such as water removal, assisting the public, or animal rescues.



Good Intent Call

Calls where no emergency is found upon arrival, such as steam or smoke mistaken for fire.



False Alarm & False Call

Incidents where alarm systems are activated by accident, malfunction, or intentional false reports.




Fire Incident Loss


Fire Incident Saved



Station 1


