NOTABLE INCIDENTS

- **OSCAR VASQUEZ (24)** was arrested on an outstanding warrant out of Florida related to 6 counts of Sexual Battery and 2 counts of Lewd or Lascivious Molestation.
- **ZZAYN RICHARDS (32)** was arrested on multiple charges ranging from Motor Vehicle Theft, Un-Authorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle, Fleeing, Reckless Driving/Extreme Indifference, and Reckless Endangerment in relation to incidents spanning across Casper, WY and Dickinson.
- **JALIL MEADOWS (23)** was arrested on multiple felony warrants out of California in relation to charges of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Prohibited Possession of a Firearm by a Felon (\$100,000 bond). MEADOWS was taken into custody and later extradited to California.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS

- **An agency assist for Mesa, AZ resulted in the arrest of Jose Vega (51) for 12 counts of Felony Sexual Assault. VEGA was taken into custody and later extradited to Arizona.**
- **Felony charges are pending in relation to an internal theft/embezzlement of over \$25K from a local bank in Dickinson.**
- **Investigators intervened in a fraudulent wire scam related to the transfer of over \$130K from Dickinson to a location in Florida, a search warrant was obtained and resulted in the recovery of over \$101K of the transferred funds.**
- **Detectives investigated a scam which resulted in a Dickinson man losing over \$300K through an online lottery scam. The case was ultimately referred to the Department of Homeland Security due to the amount of loss and the national crossover.**

NOTABLE INCIDENTS

- **JOSE MAURICIO MEHAIS PINTO** was arrested for **C-Felony Aggravated Assault Involving a Weapon, C-Felony Tampering with Evidence and B-Misdemeanor Resisting an Officer**. **PINTO** along with three others were arrested following a stabbing incident at **West Villard** apartment complex. Shortly after being lodged at the **SWMCCC**, a detainer for **PINTO** was filed by **Immigration and Customs Enforcement**.
- **KYLE LARSON (34)** was arrested for **Burglary, Resisting an Officer, Terrorizing, Ingestion of a Controlled Substance, and Alarming Acts**, after breaking into a neighbor's residence on the south side of town and briefly barricading himself in the residence with the victim still inside.
- **Mario Ramirex Vega (41)** was arrested for **Discharging Firearm within City Limits and Possession of Stolen Firearm**.
- A missing/runaway **13-year-old juvenile female** alluded officers for nearly three months before investigators were finally able to locate her in **Hebron** and return her to **Dickinson**.

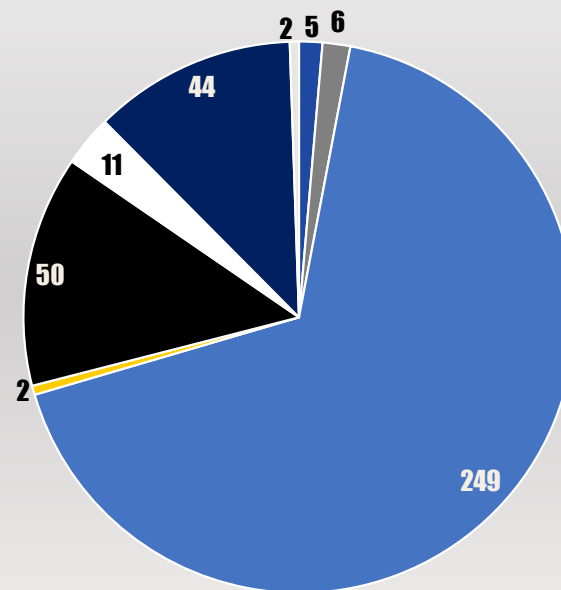
