The Cities of Lead, South Dakota and Deadwood, South Dakota, acknowledge that they have been sharing costs and expenses incurred in connection with the animal shelter, which is located in the City of Lead. The Cities further acknowledge that Lead has entered into an agreement with "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" providing that "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" will be responsible for the operation and management of the animal shelter.

The Cities of Lead and Deadwood agree to continue to be equally responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the operation and maintenance of the animal shelter located in Lead, including liability insurance for the shelter. The Cities further agree that the City of Lead and the City of Deadwood are individually responsible and liable in their connection with the animal shelter. Once an animal is delivered to the shelter each entity shall have the sole responsibility of the release of any animal that the entity delivered to the shelter. The animals will be maintained by the Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter.

Further, Lead shall be authorized to continue the agreement with "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" or make such other agreements or arrangements as deemed appropriate and necessary by the City of Lead for operation of the animal shelter.

The parties agree that Deadwood shall be billed for its share of animal shelter expenses.
