Fencing will be erected from Silverado railing to Hickoks Buliding. Deadwood st & Main st will be admission entrance for both GA and Seated guests

Restrooms at Outlaw Square will be available for attendees use - Max XXL screen will be in place on the north pad - restrooms are also available in Hickoks and Silverado.

This is a 1 band show and will start at 8 pm

September 2 - Requesting open container for zone 3 only, beer & wine only from 4:30 pm until 10 pm Beer & Wine will be sold & consumed at Outlaw Square during events. Deadwood city wide event cups will be used. Beer stands will be in place within Outlaw Square.

These is a NO RE-ENTRY events - once a guest leaves wristbands will be removed.

There are no alcohol drinks allowed in Outlaw Square footprint, which includes Deadwood St. & Main St.
