The City of Deadwood Archives is requesting permission to enter into a contract with Pannier Graphics of Gibsonia, PA to develop five (5) 24 x 36" outdoor interpretive panels as part of Deadwood's downtown walking tour.

As part of this quote, the Historic Preservation Office would like to add four new panels to the downtown walking tour. These new panels are as follows: "Reshaping the Badlands"; "South Deadwood Mining Camp"; "Wall & Main Street: Commercial Center"; and "Whitewood Creek a Short History".
