

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-20

**AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A YIELD SIGN ON LEE STREET AT ITS
INTERSECTION WITH SHERMAN STREET**

WHEREAS, the City of Deadwood is authorized to regulate traffic upon streets and highways within its jurisdiction and to designate preferential rights-of-way by the erection of stop or yield signs pursuant to SDCL 32-29-2; and

WHEREAS, Deadwood Ordinance 10.04.020(G) provides municipal authority for the placement and regulation of official traffic control devices, including traffic signs, within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the placement of a yield sign on Lee Street at its intersection with Sherman Street is appropriate to promote orderly traffic movement, designate the applicable right-of-way, and enhance public safety at the intersection; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Deadwood, South Dakota, that a yield sign is hereby authorized to be installed on Lee Street at its intersection with Sherman Street, so as to require traffic on Lee Street approaching Sherman Street to yield in accordance with applicable law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate City officials and staff are authorized and directed to install, maintain, and enforce the yield sign and any related official traffic control markings or devices consistent with SDCL 32-29-2, Deadwood Ordinance 10.04.020(g), and all other applicable laws and standards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the yield sign shall be placed so as to be visible to approaching motorists, including at night by illumination or headlight visibility, as required by SDCL 32-29-2.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective upon passage and approval by the City Commission of the City of Deadwood.
