

City of Deadwood Code of Ordinance

10.04.020 Adoption Of Traffic Regulations

The commissioners have the power by resolution to make traffic regulations as follows:

1. To designate crosswalks, establish safety zones and mark traffic lanes by appropriate lines, devices or marks on or along the street or curbing;
2. To prohibit turns and to place markers indicating method of turns;
3. To designate public carrier stands by appropriate signs;
4. To institute parking limitations and to effect such limitations;
5. To place stop signs at intersections where required for proper traffic control;
6. To designate areas within the city limits wherein diagonal parking is necessary; otherwise, parallel parking is the only type of parking allowed within the city limits;
7. To designate and mark certain streets or parts thereof as through streets, after which no vehicle shall enter such street without first coming to a complete stop nor enter such street until it has a clear right-of-way;
8. To designate truck routes and to set weight limits for vehicles using city streets;
9. To regulate the use of snowmobiles on the public ways within the city including the power to designate routes, prohibit the use of certain rights of way or portions thereof and to set speed limits.
