Re: Resolution 2026-20 Authorizing the installation of a yield sign on Lee Street at its intersection with Sherman Street.

On July 9, 2026 the Parking and Transportation Committee considered the addition of a yield sign on Lee Street at its intersection with Sherman Street. There currently is no traffic control device and traffic is expected to yield to northbound vehicles on Sherman Street. There is no compliant southbound traffic on Sherman Street at that intersection but it is important merging drivers slow down and look both ways. A stop sign was discussed but it was determined that may back traffic up on Lee Street, which is only a short distance from Pioneer Way. Most vehicles entering Sherman Street from Lee Street are making a right-hand, southbound turn onto Sherman Street which does not require a complete stop.

The addition of this sign is compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). South Dakota Codified Law 32-29-2 authorizes municipalities to erect signs such as this, and City of Deadwood Code of Ordinance 10.04.020(G) provides the Deadwood City Commission, by Resolution, may place and regulate traffic signs.

The Parking and Transportation Committee recommends adding the above discussed yield sign.
