

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

CITY OF DEADWOOD'S HIGHWAY 85 WATER MAIN EXTENSION & BOOSTER PUMP PROJECT

The City of Deadwood is seeking \$2,897,000.00 of funding from the Board of Water and Natural Resources for the Highway 85 Water Main Extension and Booster Pump Project. The funds could be either a grant from the state Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program or a loan from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program. The Drinking Water SRF loan rate will be 3.25% for up to 30 years. The Board of Water and Natural Resources may forgive all or a portion of loan principal. The amount, source of funds, and terms will be determined by the Board of Water and Natural Resources when the application is presented at a scheduled board meeting. The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the proposed project, the proposed financing, project alternatives, the source of repayment for the loan, and the impact on user fees. The public is invited to attend and comment on the project. The public hearing will be held at Deadwood City Hall (102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, SD) on Tuesday, January 16, 2024 at 5:00pm or soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.
