

The trike show n shine is designed to allow trike owners to compete for a ranking and prizes in various predertermined categories. The event will last 2 hours.

The night light parade will be held on Thursda,y July 13th. Trikes will line up in the Deadwood Event Complex and be escorted by local police department beginning at 8:30 pm. The parade should not take more than 20-30 minutes. SD DOT permits will be obtained.

PROPOSED CHANGES

9th Annual Deadwood 3 Wheel Rally July 9-14, 2023

Outlaw Square Activities – We want to collaborate with and promote more of the Outlaw Square Activities. Many of our attendees come in on Saturday and we want to draw more attention to what is happening downtown before they get here as well as what is happening throughout the week. We will be proposing having the D3WR Show n' Shine awards given out from the Outlaw Square on Wednesday afternoon following the event to keep riders close and draw spectators into town.

Road Warrior Foundation — For the past 6 years, D3WR has been working with the Road Warrior Foundation. Their mission is to provide adventures to military veterans by empowering them through challenges that honor their service. Last year the streets of Deadwood were lined with 100's of people welcoming this group as they rode through Deadwood's Main Street. D3WR was able to raise over \$2400 for them through a pie social. In 2023 we want to increase awareness and funds raised for this worthy organization. D3WR organizers will work with local businesses and media to achieve this goal.

Note: Deadwood receives recognition and promotion throughout the year from this organization in preparation for their ride here each year.

Wild Bill Me— In 2023 we will incorporate the Deadwood Chamber's "Wild Bill Me" selfie campaign. To "sweeten the pot" and encourage people to participate we will give away ten \$100 vouchers that can be used toward their 2023 D3WR lodging in Deadwood. The vouchers will only be good for services at Bid 8 Properties and are non-transferrable.

In Conclusion

The Deadwood 3 Wheeler Rally appreciates the support of Bid 8 and are asking that you fund the 9th annual Deadwood 3 Wheel Rally at the same amount you did in 2022 which was \$30,000. We are open to your ideas and suggestions as we work to improve the rally and draw more people on trikes to the area and into your businesses.

Deadwood 3 Wheel Rally OVERVIEW & FUTURE PLANS

The Deadwood 3 Wheeler Rally is an annual 5-day event is based out of Historic Deadwood, SD at the Deadwood Event Complex with daily destination rides to sites in and throughout the Black Hills area. A variety of activities also take place in downtown Deadwood and at various venues throughout town.

Despite the lingering effects of Covid-19, we had a record-breaking year in 2021 and this event continues to grow each year as indicated by the numbers below.

2021 Final Attendee Numbers:

- 819 Registrants from 41 states (up 381 participants from 2020 or 46.5% increase)
- 553 Trikes (up 245 trikes from 2020 or 44% increase)

2020 Final Attendee Numbers:

- 438 Registrants from 38 states (down 36% from 2019)
- 308 Trikes (down 35% from 2019)

2019 Final Attendee Numbers

- 690 Registrants from 39 states and 5 Canadian Provinces
- 476 Trikes

2021 Overview of Events
